Attention Jockeys: There will be a mandatory meeting between the Stewards and all jockeys at 11:15 a.m. at the jockeys tent.

There will be an officials meeting at 11:30 a.m. at the Stewards Stand.

There will be a mandatory pre-race veterinarian exam with Dr. Kelly Giunta and Dr. Reynolds Cowles. Exams will start at 8 am for first race horses. Bandages are not permitted during the examination. LASIX HORSES MUST BE ON THE GROUNDS 4 HOURS PRIOR TO POST TIME FOR THEIR SCHEDULED RACE. ALL HORSES MUST BE ON THE GROUNDS 2 HOURS PRIOR TO POST TIME FOR THE FIRST RACE UNLESS EXCUSED BY THE STEWARDS FOR EXTENUATING CIRCUMSTANCES.

THIRD PARTY FUROSEMIDE (SALIX) ADMINISTRATION

Horsemen are reminded that third party administration of furosemide (Salix) is in effect at this race meet. Please refer to the 2021 NSA Fall Condition Book for complete details of the NSA Medication policy. Contact Dr. Jeff Witwer (803-243-0328).

Foal papers are not required to be on file with the Horse Identifier at the races providing the horse can be properly identified; and tattoos or microchips are required for all horses, with a one-time exception providing the horse can be identified by his/her markings. All scratches must be made no later than one hour prior to post time for the first race.

The Foxfield race course was inspected on April 19, 2022 by Jack Sanford, Jr.

Turf: The turf consists of thick fescue, which is smooth and uniform throughout at 7" high.

Smoothness: The course is smooth throughout.

Compaction: 86 (soft).

Moisture: 9 (wet).

Notes: After one inch of rain, the course is in excellent condition, thick and lush. It will be maintained at 6-7". The course has been aerated twice, overseeded extensively and fertilized.

Each Owner and Trainer must contact the Foxfield office (434-293-9501 or information@foxfieldraces.com) before noon on April 28 to provide name(s) for their credentials to be held at the East Gate entrance.

NSA pins and parking hangers will be accepted on the day of the races but that parking will be at the Barn. Please display your parking hang tag in your vehicle. OTR ribbons will be handed out by the barn manager in the stable area. There will be no admittance to a vehicle without a hang tag.

Directions:

From the North (Washington D.C.): Take Route 29 South to 250 By-Pass West exit (Lynchburg). Get off at 1st exit (Barracks Road – Rt. 654), turn right and Foxfield is 4 miles on the left.

From the South (Lynchburg): Take Route 29 North to Barracks Road exit (Rt. 654), turn left, Foxfield is 4 miles on left.

From the East (Richmond): Take I-64 West to Shadwell (Exit 124), turn right and go 4.7 miles to Barracks Road exit (Rt. 654), turn right, Foxfield is 4 miles on left.

From the West (Waynesboro): Take I-64 East to 29 North (Exit 118-B), go 3.2 miles to Barracks Road exit (Rt. 654), turn left, Foxfield is 4 miles on left.

Avoiding Barracks Road traffic: Traveling 29 South from the Warrenton/Culpepper area, approximately 10 miles north of Charlottesville look for signs to the Charlottesville/Albemarle Airport. There is a traffic light and a car dealership called Airport Auto. This is Route 649, turn right. Go 7/10 of a mile and bear left at the airport. Go 1 mile to intersection at end of runway and bear left to stop sign. This is Route 743, turn left. Go 3 miles to bridge. Cross bridge and turn right onto Route 676 (watch for bad curves). Go 4.2 miles to end of road and turn left onto Route 601. Go 9/10 of a mile to end of road at the store and turn left. Foxfield will be on the right. Follow traffic officers and signs to East Gate.
