STABLING: All NSA Horseman parking will be located at 2605 Butler Road, 1 mile west of Falls Road. There will be temporary stabling, with a fee of \$150 per horse. Horsemen will need to bring a check payable to "Valleys Planning Council" for each stall. The checks will be collected by the stabling manager before horses are allowed to jog for the vet. No companion animals will be allowed in the stable area.

THIRD PARTY FUROSEMIDE (SALIX) ADMINISTRATION

Horsemen are reminded that third party administration of furosemide (Salix) is in effect at this race meet. Please refer to the NSA's website nationalsteeplechase.com for complete details of the NSA Medication policy. Contact Dr. Nick Meitinnis for questions (410-365-4255).

Foal papers are not required to be on file with the Horse Identifier at the races providing the horse can be properly identified; and tattoo and/or microchip is required for all horses, with a one-time exception providing the horse can be identified by its markings. All scratches must be made no later than one hour prior to post time for the first race.

A pre-race veterinary exam is required of each entry beginning at 1:00 p.m. at the stable area by Dr. Rachel Blakey and Dr. Brooke Harper. Bandages are not permitted during the examination. ALL HORSES NOT ON LASIX MUST BE ON THE GROUNDS 2 HOURS PRIOR TO POST TIME FOR THE FIRST RACE FOR THE PRE-RACE VET CHECK UNLESS EXCUSED BY THE STEWARDS FOR EXTENUATING CIRCUMSTANCES. LASIX HORSES MUST BE ON THE GROUNDS 4 HOURS PRIOR TO POST TIME FOR THEIR SCHEDULED RACE.

Scratches are due no later than 2:00 p.m. with the Clerk of Scales, Ed McLaughlin.

There will be a mandatory meeting of all jockeys with the Stewards at 1:45 p.m. at the jockeys' tent. Jockeys, please note that no advertising will be allowed on breeches. Riders with advertising on
