All jockeys are reminded to check-in with the Clerk of Scales one hour prior to post time for the first race and report his/her engagement(s) and overweight, if any.

There will be an officials meeting at 12:00 p.m. at the Stewards Stand.

There will be a mandatory veterinarian exam before the races. ALL HORSES NOT ON LASIX MUST BE ON THE GROUNDS 2 HOURS PRIOR TO POST TIME FOR THE FIRST RACE FOR THE PRE-RACE VET CHECK UNLESS EXCUSED BY THE STEWARDS FOR EXTENUATING CIRCUMSTANCES. LASIX HORSES MUST BE ON THE GROUNDS 4 HOURS PRIOR TO POST TIME FOR THEIR SCHEDULED RACE.

THIRD PARTY FUROSEMIDE (SALIX) ADMINISTRATION

horses, with a one-time exception providing the horse can be identified by its markings.

All scratches must be made no later than one hour prior to post time for the first race.

Horsemen: As required by the Virginia Department of Agriculture: "All horses must be accompanied by a report of an official negative test for equine infectious anemia (Coggins Test) conducted within the last 12 months. The Certificate must accompany all horses in order to gain access to the races. This requirement will be strictly enforced. Please turn in a copy of your Coggins test to the HORSE IDENTIFIER (Wayne VanSant).

NOTICE TO JOCKEYS AND OFFICIALS: There will be food in the Hospitality Tent. Jockeys park in the old parking lot below the Fred Barn. Follow signs into van area and take an immediate left.

Schooling will not be permitted before, during, or after the races.

The Middleburg Spring race course was inspected on April 13, 2022 by Doug Fout.

Turf: The turf consists of tall fescue.

Smoothness: The course is smooth throughout. It was rolled and chain harrowed after the 2020 fall race meet and aerated the middle of November.

Compaction: 80-107 (soft to good).

Moisture: 5-6 (average).

Notes: It has been a wet spring. The course will be mowed ten days before the race meet. There is plenty of thick turf throughout the course.
