Turf: Dense, Thick, Lush: The Brooklandwood racecourse is made up of fine, tall fescue, KY Blue Grass and perennial rye. It presents as thick, and lush with no clumping. Due to our fall drought, the irrigation was in use regularly during the fall through late November, which allowed for good germination of seed and is generally free of weed. The inside rail between Turn 3 and Turn 4 has some weed and scattered bare spots but should not be cause for concern as the hurdles and beacons will be placed on or near the middle of the course. The Club House Turn was heavily aerated and top dressed with 20+ tons of course sand immediately after last year's race. It was repeated mid-summer.

The racecourse was fertilized September 10, 2021 (35-14-3) w/ 2-3% sulphur and then again February 15, 2022 with granular Urea. **The entire racecourse received its last fertilization Wednesday, April 20, 2022 at a rate of 4 lbs. per 1,000 sq. ft. using granular fast release fertilizer (25-0-5) along with iron (2%).**

Smoothness: Very Smooth. The racecourse was Cambridge rolled April 8 after a heavy rain fall two days prior. The course is very smooth throughout. **The entire racecourse was Cambridge rolled, Sunday, April 24th, to assure high level of consistency in smoothness throughout.**

Compaction: 85-110 (GOOD) As the course has received plentiful amounts of rainfall over the winter and during the spring. It has been aerated twice with the Aerway aerator with the current course conditions listed as "GOOD" on the soil compaction tester. The racecourse was aerated, using both our Aerway and core plugged, September 2021 and then overseeded with fine turf fescue. The Aerway was used again on the entire racecourse March 22, 2022. **Compaction readings update: Remain listed (85-110) as "GOOD" on final inspection this morning.**

Moisture: 9 scale of 1-10 ("WET" on the soil moisture meter.) Until this past week, the Charlotte region has enjoyed plentiful amounts of rainfall (16.81") since January 1, 2022 with 1.91" the month of April, most of it was an appreciable rainfall event on April 5 (1.83"). The irrigation has been in use beginning April 13. We received 1.58" of rain (April 18). **No rain is forecast past Wednesday, thus irrigation will be used somewhat liberally throughout the week and turned-off Friday early morning to let it "settle in".**

Notes: Due to continued cool temperatures throughout March and April along with plentiful and measurable amounts of rainfall, the racecourse turf and going continues to be in perfect shape. Schooling, with permission, over the hurdles will be allowed once again this year on Thursday up until 2:30 pm Friday. The inside flight will be beaconed off to preserve the ground. Please call Bill Price on his cell at (704) 621-3001 for details and permission.

From Downtown Charlotte or the CLT Airport – Find your way to the I-485 Beltway (east or “Outer Loop” toward Pineville/Matthews). Get off NC Highway 521/Johnston Road (exit 61). Go approximately 11 miles south on 521/Johnston Road into South Carolina. Turn left on Highway 75 (east) toward Waxhaw/Monroe. Continue through Waxhaw - stay on Highway 75. If arriving **prior** to race day, stay on Highway 75 from Waxhaw which will lead you into Mineral Springs. Go past Gates 1 & 2, turn right onto Potter Road (at Circle K gas station). Follow Potter Road to **Gate 3**. About 1 hour from Charlotte/Douglas Airport and 25 minutes from the Ballantyne Resort – depending on race day traffic conditions.

From Camden – Take US 521 north. Bear left onto Flat Rock Road. One mile north of Heath Springs, turn right onto SC 522 East 15.8 miles toward Monroe. Highway 522 becomes Rocky River Road, cross over Highway 200 (Lancaster Highway). At .3 miles, turn left onto Crow Road, which will dead-end into Potter Road (**GATE 3** is the Horsemen's entrance) The racecourse is approximately 1 hour+ from Camden by car.

 - ❖ **NON-PARTICIPATING BUT FULLY LICENSED NSA OWNERS, TRAINERS & JOCKEYS:** Licensed 2022 NSA Horsemen wishing to gain access to the Elkridge Club luncheon tent may purchase Elkridge Club tickets at the **HORSEMEN'S CHECK-IN** tent. (see pricing below)
4. **PRICING FOR PARTICIPATING EXTRA BADGES or NON-PARTICIPATING NSA HORSEMEN**
 - ❖ Participating NSA Horsemen's Elkridge Club Badge after allotted number - \$175 per Adult/ \$85 under 21
 - ❖ Non-Participating NSA Horsemen's Elkridge Club ticket luncheon tickets - \$250 for Adult/\$150 under 21
5. **ENTRANCE TO THE ELKRIDGE CLUB:**
 - OTRs **MUST** enter through the front entrance of the Eldridge Club to exchange their meal ticket for a wristband.
 - Thereafter, OTR's may exit through the rear entrance as long as the wristband and Horsemen's Badge is displayed
 - Entry to Elkridge Club must always enter through the front entrance of the Elkridge Club.
6. **GROOMS:** will be served a light breakfast and box lunch back in the stable area, along with water and soft drinks. Grooms should get their HORSEMEN'S BADGE from the Barn Manager.
7. **SADDLING PROCEDURE:**
