ATTENTION JOCKEYS: There will be a mandatory jockey meeting at 11:30 a.m. ALL RIDERS MUST ATTEND. All jockeys are reminded to check-in with the Clerk of Scales one hour prior to post time for the first race and report his/her engagement(s) and overweight, if any.

ATTENTION OFFICIALS: There will be an officials meeting at 12:00 p.m. at the tower.

## THIRD PARTY FUROSEMIDE (SALIX) ADMINISTRATION

Horsemen are reminded that third party administration of furosemide (Salix) is in effect at this race meet. Please refer to the NSA website (nationalsteeplechase.com) for complete details of the NSA Medication policy. Contact Dr. Taryn Gassert (610-207-9209).

Foal papers will no longer be required to be on file with the Horse Identifier at the races; and tattoos or microchips are required for all horses, with a one-time exception providing the horse can be identified by his/her markings. All scratches must be made no later than one hour prior to post time for the first race.

Attention Horsemen: There will be a mandatory pre-race veterinarian exam with Dr. Kathleen Anderson and Dr. Bernadette Loomis-Smith. LASIX HORSES MUST BE ON THE GROUNDS 4 HOURS PRIOR TO POST TIME FOR THEIR SCHEDULED RACE. ALL HORSES MUST BE ON THE GROUNDS 2 HOURS PRIOR TO POST TIME FOR THE FIRST RACE UNLESS EXCUSED BY THE STEWARDS FOR EXTENUATING CIRCUMSTANCES.

DUE TO LIMITED SPACING, ONLY vans and jockeys ENTER AT GATE 3 OFF OF 926.  
Trainers not driving rigs, enter at GATE 2 to avoid overcrowding in the van parking area.

Horses will be saddled in the stable/barn area and proceed to the paddock together. This policy will be strictly enforced.

The Willowdale race course was inspected on May 8, 2022 by James Slater.

Turf: The turf is thick and consistent throughout.

Smoothness: The course is smooth throughout

Compaction: 80 (soft).

Moisture: 9 (wet).

Notes: The course is in great condition, smooth and with good turf. The 4 plain timber fences were reconstructed this year to the original design consisting of 6" rails at 42" height. Hurdle races will run over NSA national fences.

**Airports:** - Philadelphia International Airport (Approximately 35-40 minutes from Willowdale)  
- New Garden Aviation, Inc. (Private) Toughkenamon, PA 610.268.2048. Turn left out of New Garden onto Newark Road and turn right on Route 926 East. Follow 926 to its intersection with Route 82 and look for signs.  
- Chester County Airport (Private) 1 Earhart Drive, Coatesville, PA 610-383-6057. Turn right out of airport, right onto 82 South at light.

**Food Service at Races:** **Horsemen's/Grooms' lunch** will be available in the stabling area provided by the Willowdale Steeplechase. Food and beverage trucks will also be on site for food purchase.

**Jockey Club Tent:** Access to the Jockey Club Tent (includes live stream, food and beverages) will be free for race officials, and owners, trainers and riders (OTR) with horses running on race day. **Access for OTRs that do not have a horse running will be \$50pp.** These Jockey Club passes must be purchased before May 12<sup>th</sup> by calling 610.444.1582.

**Directions:** **From Philadelphia and the North:** I-95 South to Route 322 West. Take 322 West to Route 1 South to the second Kennett Square exit, Rt. 82 North. Follow Rt. 82 North to the stoplight (Rt. 926). Turn right onto Rt. 926 East. The racecourse is located on the left behind the Landhope Farms convenience store.  
**From Maryland and the South:** Take I-95 North from Baltimore to the Perryville exit (Rts. 222 & 275), just past the toll booth. At the light, turn left (away from the outlet mall). Cross over I-95 and continue straight through 2 traffic lights to the dead end. Turn right onto Rt. 276 and bear right onto Rt. 1. Follow Rt. 1 North into Pennsylvania to the Kennett Square, Rt 82 exit. Turn left onto Route 82 North. Follow Rt. 82 North to the

stoplight (Rt. 926). Turn right onto Rt. 926 East. The racecourse is located on the left behind the Landhope Farms convenience store.

**From Wilmington, DE (Rt. 52 directions):** Follow Rt. 52 North and turn left onto Rt. 1 South. Continue on Rt. 1 South to the second Kennett Square exit, Rt. 82 North. Follow Rt. 82 North to the stoplight (Rt. 926). Turn right onto Rt. 926 East. The racecourse is located on the left behind the Landhope Farms convenience store.

**From Wilmington, DE (Rt. 202 directions):** Take Rt. 202 North and turn left onto Rt. 1 South. Continue on Rt. 1 South to the second Kennett Square exit, Rt. 82 North. Follow Rt. 82 North to the stoplight (Rt. 926). Turn right onto Rt. 926 East. The racecourse is located on the left behind the Landhope Farms convenience store.

**From West Chester, PA:** Take either Rt. 52 South (or Rt. 202 South) to Rt. 926 West. Follow Rt. 926 West toward Rt. 82. Entrance will be on your right just before the traffic light at Rt. 82.
