The Winterthur race course was inspected on April 23, 2022 by Rob Plankinton and Jill Abbott.

Turf: The turf consists of a relatively thick, lush cover of native fescue and "Division One," a mixture of turf fescues, blues, and rye grass. The turf averages 6" in height and is consistent throughout.

The course was fertilized in March 2022, aerated in October 2021, and rolled in spring 2022.

Smoothness: The ground is relatively smooth throughout.

Compaction: 95 (soft). Grass cover provides good cushion.

Moisture: 8.4 (average wet).

Notes: Eight traditional "stake and bound" timber fences with telephone pole ground base rails serve as the timber course. The 1st fence is five panels wide and the remaining seven fences are four panels wide. At least two of the fences offer only one option for "run around room." However, this concern has not caused any problems in the past.
