MARKET ALLEY tracked along the inside, had to alter inwards to avoid at the fallen rider at jump seven, advanced once in the flat under urging to issue a challenge nearing the final furlong, took command at that juncture and edged clear under a drive to prevail. DOWN ROYAL established the front immediately and showed the way in hand along the inside opening up a good margin on the rest before hesitating just prior to clearing flight two, lost most of his advantage to that slight miscue but continued to shepherd the field through the jumps cleanly, widened away briefly once in the flat after the final flight before coming under challenge straightened away for home, dug in and was collared near the eighth pole, ran on well clear of the rest to be along second best. BULLET STAR tracked the front along the inside from the tail of the field jumping at times choppy almost stopping her momentum before engaging the fence, got forced to check and alter around the fallen rider at jump seven, weakened in the flat while along for the show honors. OUR FROSTY tracked just off the inside, jumped well to maintain position, got forced to be taken hold of and altered when just after completing jump seven to avoid a fallen rider, then tired in the flat. DAWN WALL tracked just off the inside, bobbled at the first flight, jumped early at fence seven and tired in the flat. WIGWAM BABY tracked along the inside, jumped well to maintain contact with the leader stalking that rival in closest aim, appeared to jump late at flight seven landing awkwardly seemingly unable to get her legs under her making contact with the ground at the knee and recovering to her feet forcing the rider from the saddle in rodeo fashion, then was walked off under her own power after being apprehended by outrider.
