Considering the fact that steeplechase races are currently "non-covered" races under HISA rules, the NSA Stewards Advisory Committee has determined, by policy, that the NSA will abide by a revised version of the HISA crop rule. Stewards will remain cognizant and enforce the limited strike rule as defined in Class 3 (1-3 strikes over 6-strike limit), however they will not disqualify a horse for a Class 2 or Class 1 violation. Note: All other penalties for Class 2 and Class 1 violations will be applied. Furthermore, NSA jockeys may use any type of ProCush crop prior to August 1, 2022, then must use a ProCush "National Hunt" model, approved by the stewards.

All scratches and rider changes must be made by 10:00 AM on Wednesdays.

All horses will be saddled in the barn.

All steeplechase races at Colonial Downs will be started by Harrison Young.

The Colonial Downs course will be set up with 5 flights of National Fences (3 down the back side and 2 on the front side). The first fence in the stretch the last time around will NOT be jumped.

ALL OWNERS, TRAINERS AND RIDERS MUST BE PROPERLY LICENSED WITH THE NSA BEFORE THEY WILL BE ALLOWED TO PARTICPATE. A LICENSE WITH THE VIRGINIA RACING COMMISSION IS NOT REQUIRED.

WORKERS COMPENSATION

Trainer certifies that he/she has secured certification evidencing the maintenance of Workers Compensation Insurance coverage for all employed personnel in accordance with the statutory requirements of the Commonwealth of Virginia and Colonial Downs Racetrack House Rules and the insurance company providing such coverage, the policy number and its date of issue are as follows: Trainers shall furnish to Colonial Downs a copy of a notice to trainer's workers compensation carrier, directing such workers compensation carrier to notify Colonial Downs in the event of cancellation.

COGGINS TEST, HEALTH CERTIFICATE AND INOCULATIONS

Coggins Test: All horses (including ponies) must have a current negative Coggins test dated within the twelve (12) months and which is valid for the duration of the meet. Health Certificate: A valid health certificate dated within 24 hours from the point of origin with proof of Equine Herpes Type-1 (EHV-1) vaccination (between 14-120) days are required to enter Colonial Downs Stable Area.

TRAINER NOTICES

Trainers must be in their assigned stall(s) no less than 5 hrs. prior to post. Also, the trainer shall have a representative available to assist the VRC veterinarian with the pre-race exam. If there is a problem with your stall please contact the racing department. If you wish to ship in to another trainer's barn you must obtain permission from the stall superintendent.

All horses running at Colonial Downs must be tattooed or microchipped, and be on the grounds 5 hours prior to post time of their race. Foal papers are NOT required unless papers are needed to properly identify the horse.

150-Day Layoff Report Forms

Entries for horses that have not raced for 150 days or more (excluding first-time starters) will not be accepted unless the trainer has completed and submitted a 150-Day Layoff Report Form. For races at Colonial Downs, please submit all reports directly to Dr. Ada Caruthers (ada.caruthers@vrc.virginia.gov). RIDER NOTICES

All jump riders must ride in a helmet approved by the NSA and use a ProCush Whip. All riders are required to report to the jockeys' room at the HBPA office on the backside no later than two hours before post time for the first race.

The HISA whip rule will be in effect at Colonial Downs, per order of the NSA Stewards Advisory Committee.

Riders, please note that the overgirth is NOT to be included in the assigned weight when weighing out or in.

PURSE DISTRIBUTION

All purse monies will be distributed through the NSA Central Bookkeeping System as follows: 60% to the winner, 18% to second, 10% to third and 7% to fourth. A \$1,000 participation incentive will be paid to owners that finish after fourth place. All trainers will receive \$300 per race regardless of the finish to be paid by the Colonial Downs Bookkeeper.

The NSA will deduct an administrative fee equivalent to 3% of the purse from owners whose horses earn a portion of the purse. Runners Reward applies, with all fees waived for any horse which runs and does not earn a portion of the purse.

Other fees: Per start fee of \$15 to the Thoroughbred Aftercare Alliance.

NSA SHOE POLICY

No toe grabs, caulks, stickers, turndowns, inserts, trailers, or heel extensions will be allowed on the front or hind shoes. Note: The insert on the toe of the Queen's Plate is considered a "wear plate," not a toe grab. Block heels on the hind shoes (not to exceed 1/4 inch) are permissible. Outer rim shoes are allowable providing there is no toe grab.

Virginia Breds are preferred in all races. Virginia bred, Virginia sired, and Virginia certified horses that win are eligible for a 25% bonus, capped at \$10,000, to be paid by the Virginia Thoroughbred Association. Bonuses are not considered part of purse earnings.
