NSA Code of Conduct - As a condition of license, all NSA licensees are expected to conduct themselves in a manner consistent with the best interests of racing. Any conduct deemed to be detrimental to the sport, the NSA, or the individual race meets and their representatives, or conduct prejudicial to the sport's reputation, will subject the offender to a fine or suspension, or both, in accordance with the NSA Rules of Racing.

Attention Jockeys: There will be a mandatory meeting between the Stewards and all jockeys at 11:15 a.m. at the jockeys tent.

New NSA Weighing Policy - Riders, please note that the overgirth, breastplate (or yoke) are not to be included in the assigned weight when weighing out or in. Therefore, these pieces of safety equipment should not be included with your tack weighing out, and must be dropped (along with your helmet and crop) before getting on the scale to weigh in.

There will be an officials meeting at 11:30 a.m. at the Stewards Stand.

There will be a mandatory pre-race veterinarian exam with Dr. Donovan Dagner, Dr. Kelly Giunta, Dr. Susanna Charland, and Dr. Megan Medoff. Exams will start at 8 am for first race horses. Bandages are not permitted during the examination. LASIX HORSES MUST BE ON THE GROUNDS 4 HOURS PRIOR TO POST TIME FOR THEIR SCHEDULED RACE. ALL HORSES MUST BE ON THE GROUNDS 2 HOURS PRIOR TO POST TIME FOR THE FIRST RACE UNLESS EXCUSED BY THE STEWARDS FOR EXTENUATING CIRCUMSTANCES.

THIRD PARTY FUROSEMIDE (SALIX) ADMINISTRATION

Horsemen are reminded that third party administration of furosemide (Salix) is in effect at this race meet. Please refer to the 2022 NSA Fall Condition Book for complete details of the NSA Medication policy. Contact Dr. Jeff Witwer (803-243-0328).

Foal papers are not required to be on file with the Horse Identifier at the races providing the horse can be properly identified; and tattoos or microchips are required for all horses, with a one-time exception providing the horse can be identified by his/her markings. All scratches must be made no later than one hour prior to post time for the first race.

The Foxfield racecourse was inspected on September 17, 2022 by Jack Sanford, Jr.

Turf: The turf is uniform at 6" and will be maintained at that height.

Smoothness: The course is smooth throughout.

Compaction: 94 (soft)

Moisture: 8 (average wet)

Notes: The course is in good condition. It has been deep tined aerated twice in the last month. The turf is very uniform, and there are very few weeds after an aggressive weed kill after last spring's races.

Horsemen should be aware of heavy traffic and be on grounds by 10am. All barn traffic enters the East Gate.

From the North (Washington D.C.): Take Route 29 South to 250 By-Pass West exit (Lynchburg). Get off at 1st exit (Barracks Road – Rt. 654), turn right and Foxfield is 4 miles on the left.

From the South (Lynchburg): Take Route 29 North to Barracks Road exit (Rt. 654), turn left, Foxfield is 4 miles on left.

From the East (Richmond): Take I-64 West to Shadwell (Exit 124), turn right and go 4.7 miles to Barracks Road exit (Rt. 654), turn right, Foxfield is 4 miles on left.

From the West (Waynesboro): Take I-64 East to 29 North (Exit 118-B), go 3.2 miles to Barracks Road exit (Rt. 654), turn left, Foxfield is 4 miles on left.
