THIRD PARTY FUROSEMIDE (SALIX) ADMINISTRATION

Horsemen are reminded that third party administration of furosemide (Salix) is in effect at this race meet. Please refer to the 2021 NSA Fall Condition Book for complete details of the NSA Medication policy. Contact Dr. Jeff Witwer (803-243-0328).

There will be a mandatory pre-race vet check at the stable area with Dr. Rachel Blakey and Dr. Brooke Harper starting at 10:00 a.m. LASIX HORSES MUST BE ON THE GROUNDS 4 HOURS PRIOR TO POST TIME FOR THEIR SCHEDULED RACE. ALL HORSES MUST BE ON THE GROUNDS 2 HOURS PRIOR TO POST TIME FOR THE FIRST RACE UNLESS EXCUSED BY THE STEWARDS FOR EXTENUATING CIRCUMSTANCES.

Foal papers are not required to be on file with the Horse Identifier at the races providing the horse can be properly identified; and tattoos or microchips are required for all horses, with a one-time exception providing the horse can be identified by his/her markings. All scratches must be made no later than one hour prior to post time for the first race.

ATTENTION JOCKEYS: There will be a mandatory meeting of all jockeys with the Stewards at 11:15 a.m. at the Jockeys' Tent. ALL RIDERS MUST ATTEND. All jockeys are reminded to check-in with the Clerk of Scales one hour prior to post time for the first race and report his/her engagement(s) and overweight, if any.

NEW 2022 RACE DAY PROCEDURES

Saddling Procedures:

- Saddling for all races to take place at the Stabling Area, no exceptions.
- Jockeys' Tent will be located next to the Stabling Area. (Primary scales will be located next to the Jockeys' Tent.)
- Horses will gather at the Stabling Area in advance and walk to the paddock as a group (see attached map for route depicted in dotted line).

Scales Procedures:

1. All riders will weigh out using the scales at the stables.
2. At the end of each race, all riders except the winner, will ride back down to the stabling area and meet their grooms by the gate nearest to the stables.
 - a. Riders will dismount at the stabling area.
 - b. Riders will weigh back in at the stabling area.
3. The winning rider will dismount at the finish line.
 - a. There is a second set of scales for the winning rider next to the trophy stand.
 - b. Winning rider to weigh in at the trophy stand/finish line.
 - i. Their weight will be relayed back to the main set of scales via radio.
 - ii. Winning rider will get into a shuttle to ride back down to the barn for the next race.

Shuttles:

- Jockey shuttles will be available to transport riders/grooms/trainers to-and-from the stabling area to the paddock.
- If trainers are running multiple horses, please plan accordingly with additional grooms. This will help keep races running on time.

ATTENTION GROOMS: It is recommended that grooms view the race from the rail just outside the paddock. The Groom of the winning horse can then easily make their way to the finish line to collect the horse and take it back to the stabling area. Grooms of all other horses can get into a shuttle, ride back down to the barn, and meet the horse/rider at the gate nearest to the stabling area.

STABLING: NSA Horseman parking can be accessed via the driveway off Shawan Road, approximately one quarter mile west of the intersection of Shawan Road and Cuba Road / Beaver Dam Road. Land Preservation Trust will provide temporary stabling at a fee of \$150 per horse. Horsemen will need to bring a check payable to "Land Preservation Trust" for each stall; checks will be collected by the stabling manager before horses are allowed to jog for the vet. No companion animals will be allowed in the stable area.

MEDICAL: Special Events Medical Services (SEMS) provides field trauma support and works within the parameters of the Maryland Institute for Emergency Medical Services Systems (MIEMSS). Note: SEMS utilizes John Deere Gator vehicles specifically modified for field trauma use. A team of qualified physicians is present to supervise medical activities and to perform examinations following a fall.

OTR / VOLUNTEER NOTICE: Boxed lunches will be provided to race officials, volunteers, and horsemen at the horsemen's stabling area beginning at 12:00 PM. The Legacy Chase committee will be hosting a reception for race officials, volunteers, owners, trainers, and riders immediately following the last race in the tent next to the stabling area.

Course Report: The Shawan Downs course was inspected on Monday, September 19 by Bruce Fenwick.

Compaction: Readings range from 100 (soft) to 140 (firm) throughout the course.

Moisture: 8 - 10 (average wet - wet)

Turf: The turf has been aerated and mowed and it is lush throughout.

Smoothness: The course is smooth throughout.

Notes: The course got a substantial amount of rain last week, which was the perfect amount.
