ATTENTION JOCKEYS: There will be a meeting of all jockeys with the stewards at 11:45 a.m. ALL RIDERS MUST ATTEND. All jockeys are reminded to check-in with the Clerk of Scales one hour prior to post time of the first race and report his/her engagement(s) and overweight, if any.

There will be an officials' meeting at 12:00 p.m. at the Stewards Stand.

There will be a mandatory pre-race vet check with Dr. Lisa Handy, Dr. Margot Boerner, and Dr. Doug Berry. Bandages are not permitted during the examination. LASIX HORSES MUST BE ON THE GROUNDS 4 HOURS PRIOR TO POST TIME FOR THEIR SCHEDULED RACE. ALL HORSES MUST BE ON THE GROUNDS 2 HOURS PRIOR TO POST TIME FOR THE FIRST RACE UNLESS EXCUSSED BY THE STEWARDS FOR EXTENUATING CIRCUMSTANCES.

THIRD PARTY FUROSEMIDE (SALIX) ADMINISTRATION Horsemen are reminded that third party administration of furosemide (Salix) is in effect at this race meet. Please refer to the NSA website nationalsteeplechase.com for complete details of the NSA Medication policy. Contact Dr. Jeff Witwer (803-243-0328). ALL LASIX HORSES MUST BE ON THE GROUNDS NO LATER THAN 4 HOURS PRIOR TO POST TIME FOR THEIR RACE. HOWEVER, ALL HORSES MUST BE ON THE GROUNDS NO LATER THAN 10:00 A.M. FOR THE PRE-RACE VETERINARY EXAMS.

Attention Horsemen: All scratches must be made no later than one hour prior to post time for the first race.

REMINDER: Foal papers are not required to be on file with the Horse Identifier at the races; and tattoos or microchips are required for all horses with a one-time exception provided the horse can be identified by its markings.

The Aiken racecourse was inspected on Sunday, October 16 by Anne Pezzano and Doug Tribert.

Turf: The turf consists of Tifway 419 Bermuda grass overseeded with winter rye.

Smoothness: The course was dragged and aerated after the spring meeting and is smooth.

Compaction: 100 (soft)

Moisture: 8.3 (average wet)

Notes: The course was chain-dragged teeth down, fertilized, and broadcast on September 13. Irrigation is running every night.

NSA MEMBERS: NSA pins and parking hangers will be accepted on the day, but as General Admission ONLY. The cost to access the Horsemen's Tent for any NSA member or guest that does not have a horse entered is \$100 per person.
