IMPORTANT NOTICE: There will be a mandatory pre-race veterinary exam with Dr. Amy Snyder (Genesee Valley Equine Clinic) at the on-site stabling area from 8:00 to 9:00 a.m. Bandages are not permitted during the examination.

All Lasix payments must be made up front on race day.

LASIX HORSES MUST BE ON THE GROUNDS 4 HOURS PRIOR TO POST TIME FOR THEIR SCHEDULED RACE. ALL HORSES MUST BE ON THE GROUNDS 2 HOURS PRIOR TO POST TIME FOR THE FIRST RACE UNLESS EXCUSED BY THE STEWARDS FOR EXTENUATING CIRCUMSTANCES.

THIRD PARTY FUROSEMIDE (SALIX) ADMINISTRATION: Horsemen are reminded that third party administration of furosemide (Salix) is in effect at this race meet. Please refer to the 2021 NSA Fall Condition Book for complete details of the new NSA Medication policy. Contact Dr. Lauren Powell (585-991-3137).

ATTENTION JOCKEYS: There will be a mandatory meeting of all jockeys with the Stewards at 11:45 a.m. at the Jockeys' Tent.

NOTE: Smoking and/or vaping is prohibited in the barn area and jockeys' quarters.

There will be an officials' meeting at 12:00 p.m. at the Jockeys Tent.

Foal papers are not required to be on file with the Horse Identifier at the races providing the horse can be properly identified; and tattoos or microchips are required for all horses, with a one time exception providing the horse can be identified by its markings. All scratches must be made no later than one hour prior to post time for the first race.

Turf: A very dry summer did not produce much new grass. However, recent rains on the grass, which was kept fairly long, has produced a consistent, thick turf. The grass is now at 6 inches.

Smoothness: A lack of racing and livestock on this course has made the course much smoother, along with aerating and mowing.

Compaction: 70 (deep).

Moisture: 6 (average).
