PATROL JUDGES: Mandatory meeting at 11AM in front of the Steward Stand on the course. Anyone who asked for a printed license from VGCA should see Pat Carle at the Clerk of the Scales room to pick up.

JOCKEYS: There will be a mandatory meeting of all jockeys with the Stewards at 11:15AM. ALL RIDERS MUST ATTEND. All jockeys are reminded to check-in with the Clerk of Scales one hour prior to post time for the first race and report his/her engagement(s) and overweight, if any.

**JOCKEYS MUST REMAIN IN THE JOCKEY TENT BETWEEN RACES AND ARE NOT PERMITTED TO GO TO THE BARN AREA.**  
**TRAINERS ARE REMINDED TO BRING A SUFFICIENT NUMBER OF GROOMS, AS JOCKEYS WILL NOT BE ALLOWED TO LEAVE THE JOCKEY TENT.**

**There will be a mandatory veterinarian pre-race exam for all horses. Examinations will begin at 8:45AM and end by 11:00AM. Horses will be called up in race order. Horses on Lasix must be on the grounds four (4) hours prior to their scheduled post time, but no later than 9:00 AM for pre-race exams.**

**All owners, trainers, riders and grooms participating in the International Gold Cup races are required to be licensed by the Virginia Racing Commission (VRC).**

The license forms and instructions may be downloaded from our website [www.vrc.virginia.gov](http://www.vrc.virginia.gov) by clicking on "Virginia Racing License" on the left-hand side of the homepage. There are no license fees, and all participants will be issued a three-year license. Please note: All participants must be fingerprinted upon making their initial application and pay a \$30 processing fee. Participants with a record of recently being fingerprinted in Virginia will normally not have to go through the process again. Once an application is completed, signed, and dated it may be scanned with payment, if needed, and emailed to [VRClicense@vrc.virginia.gov](mailto:VRClicense@vrc.virginia.gov).

Grooms must have a VRC license unless they have a current license from another jurisdiction with them, in which case they may obtain a day pass.

Individuals under the age of 16 are not allowed in the stable area.  
Dogs are not permitted on the grounds.

**THIRD PARTY FUROSEMIDE (SALIX) ADMINISTRATION:**

Horsemen are reminded that third party administration of furosemide (Salix) is in effect at this race meet. Please refer to the NSA website ([nationalsteeplechase.com](http://nationalsteeplechase.com)) for complete details of the NSA Medication policy. Contact Dr. Jeff Witwer (803-243-0328).

**ALL HORSES WILL BE SADDLED IN THE BARN BEFORE EVERY RACE. NO SADDLING IN THE PADDOCK.**

Horses will be led to the paddock TOGETHER before each race. The trainer or their designate will be responsible for transporting the tack after weighing out back to the barn for saddling. Jockeys are not allowed in the stabling area. **If trainers have multiple horses in a race or horses in back-to-back races, please make appropriate plans as it is imperative that we stay on schedule.**

Foal papers are no longer required to be on file with the Horse Identifier at the races, providing the horse can be properly identified; and tattoo and/or microchip is required for all horses, with a one-time exception providing the horse can be identified by its markings.

All scratches after 10:00am on Wednesday, October 19th, must be made no later than 11:00AM on race day.

**HORSEMEN:** Horses shipping to the International Gold Cup must have a Health Certificate dated within the last 5 days, with the following information: Horses have not originated from a barn with a case or suspect case of Herpes virus, been vaccinated with EHV-1 no less than 7 days and no more than 120 days, and a Coggins test conducted within 12 months.

**STABLING:** Stalls will be provided for each entry. Contact Thomas C. Williams (Reggie) at 703-843-6385. Notify Reggie if you are planning to bring an AE horse as well.

**NOTICE TO OFFICIALS:** A box lunch will be provided along with bottled water. Must wear wristband provided in ticket envelope and have VRC license to receive lunch and access to Steward Stand/Course.

**NO SCHOOLING ON THE COURSE RACE WEEK.** The course will be available for walking on Thursday, October 20, 2022

The Great Meadow race course was inspected by Don Yovanovich on October 16, 2022.

**Turf:** The course will be mowed at 6 inches this week. There is a mat of clippings as thick as can be and a rich and thick covering of Blue Grass Turf Fescue that was fertilized in March.

**Smoothness:** The course was rolled after the Virginia Gold Cup in May and is smooth.

**Compaction:** 100 (soft). Much of the course is a bit softer.

**Moisture:** 8 - 9 (average wet - wet).

**Notes:** Great Meadow had a cool and overcast week, so little drying occurred since the first inspection on October 9, 2022. The forecast for the week beginning October 16 is similar to last week. There is a shower predicted for early Monday morning.
