NSA Code of Conduct - As a condition of license, all NSA licensees are expected to conduct themselves in a manner consistent with the best interests of racing. Any conduct deemed to be detrimental to the sport, the NSA, or the individual race meets and their representatives, or conduct prejudicial to the sport's reputation, will subject the offender to a fine or suspension, or both, in accordance with the NSA Rules of Racing.

ATTENTION JOCKEYS: All jockeys are reminded to check in with the Clerk of Scales one hour prior to the time of the first race and report his/her engagement(s) and overweight, if any. There will be a mandatory meeting of all jockeys with the Stewards at 11:30 am at the Jockey Building. ALL RIDERS MUST ATTEND.

New NSA Weighing Policy - Riders, please note that the overgirth, breastplate (or yoke) are not to be included in the assigned weight when weighing out or in. Therefore, these pieces of safety equipment should not be included with your tack weighing out, and must be dropped (along with your helmet and crop) before getting on the scale to weigh in.

VIRGINIA FALL WEIGHING IN POLICY: The only jockeys who will dismount and weigh in at the Judges' Stand will be the winning jockey and any jockey claiming foul. The other jockeys will stay mounted and return to the paddock to dismount. These jockeys will weigh in at the same scales they weighed out on. The weigh in at the finish will be handled by a second Clerk of the Scales. The riders who do weigh in at the finish will have a gator waiting to take them to the Jocks' Room.

Except for the winner, all other horses and riders must make their way back to the paddock by way of the gallop lane and finish line, and must ride off course directly into the paddock to meet grooms and dismount. Do not dismount or remove tack until you are in the paddock.

THIRD PARTY FUROSEMIDE (LASIX) ADMINISTRATION: Horsemen are reminded that third party administration of furosemide (Lasix) is in effect at his race meet. Please refer to the NSA website (www.nationalsteeplechase.com) for complete details of the NSA medication policy. Contact Dr. Jeff Whitwer (803-243-0328).

STALLS: All horses will have stalls. If you have a special request, please call Will O'Keefe at 540-439-3848 (leave a message) or email wfo1717@gmail.com no later than Thursday, October 7, 2022. A single bag of bedding will be available for each stall. OVERNIGHT STABLING IS NOT AVAILABLE.

VET EXAM: There will be a mandatory pre-race veterinary jog exam with Dr. William McCormick at 9:30 am. Jog goes in race order (Race 1, Race 2, Race 3, etc). Bandages are not permitted during the examination. LASIX HORSES MUST BE ON THE GROUNDS FOUR (4) HOURS PRIOR TO POST TIME FOR THEIR SCHEDULED RACE. ALL HORSES MUST BE ON THE GROUNDS TWO (2) HOURS PRIOR TO POST TIME FOR THE FIRST RACE UNLESS EXCUSED BY THE STEWARDS FOR EXTENUATING CIRCUMSTANCES. HORSE ARRIVAL IS SCHEDULED FOR 7:30-9:30

AM, SATURDAY, OCTOBER 8, 2022. POST TIME FOR THE FIRST RACE IS 12:30 PM.

Foal papers are not required to be on file with the Horse Identifier at the races providing the horse can be properly identified; tattoos and microchips are required for all horses, with a one-time exception providing the horse can be identified by its markings.

All scratches must be made no later than one hour prior to post time for the first race.

No toe grabs, caulks, stickers, turndowns, inserts, trailers, or heel extensions will be allowed on the front or hind shoes. Note: The insert on the toe of the Queen's Plate is considered a "wear plate", not a toe grab. Block heels on the hind shoes (not to exceed 1/4 inch) are permissible. Outer rim shoes are allowable providing there is no toe grab.

Further Clarification: No protrusions below the ground surface of the shoe is the target of the rule. On outer rims, consider the rim itself to be the ground surface and grind the toe grabs down flush with it. On everything else the grab gets ground down to flush with the shoe's surface. There are a variety of Block Heels available from various manufacturers. As long as they're labeled Block Heels from the maker, they are permitted. Again, with the toes ground flush to the surrounding shoe surface.

Shoes will be inspected before each race.

As required by the Virginia Department of Agriculture: All horses (including horses originating within Virginia) entering the Virginia Fall Races must have an official health certificate dated within 30 days of entry and signed by a licensed veterinarian. The document must contain the following statement: Horses represented on this certificate have not originated from a barn with a confirmed or suspected case of Equine Herpes Virus or Strangles, have not shown signs suggestive of these diseases, and have not been febrile within the previous three weeks. Rectal temperature for each horse at the time of examination must be recorded on the health certificate. Coggins test must be conducted within 12 months, and the test report must be presented with the health certificate. The test must be valid to cover the time the horse is expected to be within the facility.

The Virginia Fall racecourse was inspected on October 3, 2022 by Doug Fout.

Turf: The course consists of fescue, which was mowed on Thursday, September 29 at 6 inches.

Smoothness: The course is smooth throughout.

Compaction: 103 (good)

Moisture: 5 (average)

Notes: The course has received 2 1/2 inches of rainfall over the last few days and more rain is expected.

Arrival times are assigned. NO EXCEPTIONS.
