There will be an Officials' Meeting at 12:00 p.m. at the Stewards Stand.

ATTENTION JOCKEYS: There will be a mandatory meeting of all jockeys with the stewards at 11:45 a.m. at the Jockeys' Tent. ALL RIDERS MUST ATTEND. All jockeys are reminded to check-in with the Clerk of Scales one hour prior to post time of the first race and report his/her engagement(s) and overweight, if any. SHOWERS WILL BE AVAILABLE ON RACE DAY, PLEASE PROVIDE YOUR OWN TOWEL.

There will be a mandatory pre-race vet check with Dr. Chris Earnst and Dr. Susannah Kennedy. Bandages are not permitted during the examination. LASIX HORSES MUST BE ON THE GROUNDS 4 HOURS PRIOR TO POST TIME FOR THEIR SCHEDULED RACE. ALL HORSES MUST BE ON THE GROUNDS 2 HOURS PRIOR TO POST TIME FOR THE FIRST RACE UNLESS EXCUSED BY THE STEWARDS FOR EXTENUATING CIRCUMSTANCES.

THIRD PARTY FUROSEMIDE (SALIX) ADMINISTRATION Horsemen are reminded that third party administration of furosemide (Salix) is in effect at this race meet. Please refer to the NSA website nationalsteeplechase.com for complete details of the NSA Medication policy. Contact Dr. Jeff Witwer (803-243-0328). ALL LASIX HORSES MUST BE ON THE GROUNDS NO LATER THAN 4 HOURS PRIOR TO POST TIME FOR THEIR RACE. HOWEVER, ALL HORSES MUST BE ON THE GROUNDS NO LATER THAN 10:00 A.M. FOR THE PRE-RACE VETERINARY EXAMS.

Attention Horsemen: All scratches must be made no later than one hour prior to post time for the first race.

REMINDER: Foal papers are not required to be on file with the Horse Identifier at the races; and tattoos or microchips are required for all horses with a one-time exception provided the horse can be identified by its markings.

ATTENTION TRAINERS: By order of the South Carolina State Veterinarian, all racehorses, ponies, donkeys and any other horses entering the Steeplechase of Charleston must have the following documents:

- Requirements for out of state horses:

1. CVI - Certificate of Veterinary Inspection (valid for 30 days) including description, date of negative EIA (Coggins) results, Lab and Accession number; and

2. Negative EIA (Coggins) test within 12 months

- Requirements for in-state (South Carolina) horses:

1. Negative EIA (Coggins) test within 12 months

These documents may be checked by State Inspectors on race day.

RACE DAY TRAFFIC: Very heavy traffic is to be expected on race day, please be advised of new traffic patterns and parking. PLEASE USE NSA HANGTAG TO GAIN ENTRY INTO THE IN-FIELD PARKING LOT (use Gate 3). NO CARS WILL BE ALLOWED IN STABLE AREA.

NON-PARTICIPATING HORSEMEN: NSA pins and hang tags will be considered General Admission only.

Owners will receive two (2) Hendrick Lexus VIP Lounge tickets. Trainers and Riders will receive one (1) Hendrick Lexus VIP Lounge ticket. The Stonoferry racecourse was inspected on Sunday, October 30 by Tom Divers and Toby Edwards.

Turf: The turf is a mixture of semi-dormant Bermuda and other natives grasses, standings at 5-6 inch- es in height with a good cover overall.

Smoothness: The course is smooth throughout. It has been rolled and harrowed regularly. Compaction: 130-140 (firm). The course was aerated in early October, but due to lack of rain, the course is firmer than we would like. -- Compaction Update: The course received a quarter of an inch of rain on Monday morning, October 31, and was aerated immediately thereafter, reducing the compaction to 100-110 (good).

Moisture: 2 (dry). October rainfall totaled to one inch with no significant rainfall in the forecast. During the inspection, there was a misting rain, but it only amounted to 5/100ths of an inch.

Notes: Should the course receive rain, it will be aerated early during race week. At the current time, the ground is too firm for the aerator to have any impact in reducing the compaction levels.
