ATTENTION JOCKEYS: There will be a mandatory meeting of all jockeys with the Stewards at 11:15 a.m. at the jockeys room. ALL RIDERS MUST ATTEND. Jockeys are reminded to check-in with the Clerk of Scales one hour prior to post time of the first race and report his/her engagement(s) and overweight, if any. NOTE: smoking and/or vaping is prohibited in the barn area and jockeys' quarters.

There will be an Official's Meeting at the Judge's Stand at 11:30 a.m.

There will be a mandatory pre-race veterinary exam with Dr. Rebecca Kramer and Dr. Reynolds Cowles.

THIRD PARTY FUROSEMIDE (LASIX) ADMINISTRATION: Horsemen are reminded that third party administration of furosemide (Lasix) is in effect at his race meet. Please refer to the NSA website (www.nationalsteeplechase.com) for complete details of the NSA medication policy.

LASIX HORSES MUST BE ON THE GROUNDS FOUR (4) HOURS PRIOR TO POST TIME FOR THEIR SCHEDULED RACE. ALL HORSES MUST BE ON THE GROUNDS TWO (2) HOURS PRIOR TO POST TIME FOR THE FIRST RACE UNLESS EXCUSED BY THE STEWARDS FOR EXTENUATING CIRCUMSTANCES.

Foal papers are not required to be on file with the Horse Identifier at the races providing the horse can be properly identified; and tattoos or microchips are required for all horses, with a one-time exception providing the horse can be identified by its markings. All scratches must be made no later than one hour prior to post time for the first race.

Course Update: Readings from November 2, 2022 - Compaction: 90-110 (soft-good), Moisture: 8.5 (average wet), Rain on Monday increased with moisture reading. No more rain in the forecast.

The Montpelier racecourse was inspected on Friday, October 21 by Brooke Royster, Co-Director of Racing, and Martha Strawther, Executive Director.

Turf: The turf is about 7 inches long and mowing before the races is not anticipated.

Smoothness: The course was rolled two weeks ago and is smooth.

Compaction: 110 (good)

Moisture: 5-7 (average - average wet)

Notes: Half an inch of rain on two separate occasions in the last week has brought up the moisture level and the length of the grass should slow down drying. The weather forecast predicts some chance of showers, warm days and cool nights that should insure another inch or so of grass growth and good conditions to maintain the moisture level.
