ATTENTION JOCKEYS: There will be a mandatory meeting of all jockeys with the Stewards at 12:15 p.m. at the Stewards Stand. ALL RIDERS MUST ATTEND. All jockeys are reminded to check-in with the Clerk of Scales one hour prior to post time for the first race and report his/her engagement(s) and overweight, if any. NOTE: Smoking and/or vaping is prohibited in the stabling tent area.

There will be an officials meeting at the Stewards Stand at 12:30 p.m.

There will be a mandatory pre-race veterinarian exam beginning at 9:00 a.m. with Dr. Kathy Anderson and Dr. Bernadette Loomis-Smith. Only horses that passed pre-race exam will proceed to LASIX VET. LASIX HORSES MUST BE ON THE GROUNDS 4 HOURS PRIOR TO POST TIME FOR THEIR SCHEDULED RACE. ALL HORSES MUST BE ON THE GROUNDS 2 HOURS PRIOR TO POST TIME FOR THE FIRST RACE UNLESS EXCUSED BY THE STEWARDS FOR EXTENUATING CIRCUMSTANCES.

Foal papers are not required to be on file with the Horse Identifier at the races providing the horse can be properly identified; and tattoos or microchips are required for all horses, with a one-time exception providing the horse can be identified by its markings. All scratches must be made no later than one hour prior to post time for the first race.

**Course Update:** Readings from November 2, 2022 - Compaction: 96 (soft), Moisture: 4.6 (average dry), The course has been mowed at 6 inches.

The Pennsylvania Hunt Cup racecourse was inspected on October 26, 2022 by Brooke Boyer and Andrea Collins.

Turf: Lush fescue, drill seeded in September has flourished with the recent rain.

Smoothness: The course is smooth throughout.

Compaction: 81 (soft)

Moisture: 4.6 (average dry)

Notes: The course will be mowed to a height of 6 inches before the race. The second to last fence has been changed to a Stake-and-Bound of similar height and composition as the last fence with a brush ground line.

### **From West Chester/Paoli**

Route 202 South to Route 926 (Street Road) West. Follow Route 926 (pass New Bolton Center ) and continue to intersection of Newark Road.

Gate #1 – Turn right on Newark Road and go approximately ¼ mile and entrance will be on the left.

Gate #2 – Stay on Route 926 West, go approximately ¾ mile to entrance on your right.

### **From New York / New Jersey**

New Jersey Turnpike to Route 295 South – Cross Commodore Barry Bridge . Take 95 South to Route 322 West (to West Chester ). Follow 322 to Route 1. Turn left on Route 1 South. Follow Route 1 South past Longwood Gardens to Toughkenamon Exit. Turn right (North) on Newark Road and go approximately 3-4 miles to intersection of Route 926 (Street Road). Follow gate directions above.

### **From Maryland**

Take 95 North to Exit 93 (Port Deposit). Take Route 275 North to Route 276 North to Route 1. Go North on Route 1 to Toughkenamon Exit. Turn left (North) onto Newark Road and go approximately 3-4 miles to intersection of Route 926 (Street Road) and Newark Road. Follow gate directions above.

### **From Delaware**

Route 52 North to Route 1. Turn left (South) on Route 1 to Toughkenamon Exit. Turn right (North) on Newark Road and go approximately 3 – 4 miles to intersection of Route 926 (Street Road) and Newark Road. Follow gate directions above.

### **From Lancaster**

Route 41 South to Route 926 (East). Bear left on Route 926 (Street Road) and go approximately 5-6 miles to Gate #2. Continue past Gate #2 if appropriate, to stop sign, turn left onto Newark Road and follow directions to Gate #1.

### **From Harrisburg**

Take Pennsylvania Turnpike to Downingtown Exit. Take Route 202 South to Route 1. Turn right (South) on Route 1 to Toughkenamon Exit. Turn right (North) on Newark Road and go approximately 3-4 miles to intersection of Route 926 (Street Road) and Newark Road. Follow gate directions above.
