Course Update: On Sunday, March 19, compaction readings ranged from 90-110 (soft-good) and moisture readings ranged from 8-10 (average wet-wet). The compaction is being managed with intermittent irrigation.

The Aiken Steeplechase racecourse was inspected on Saturday, March 11 by Anne Pezzano and Doug Tribert.

Turf: The turf is Tifway 419 Bermuda overseeded with annual rye.

Smoothness: The course is mostly smooth. Following the fall meet, the course was chain-dragged and rolled three times before aerating two times.

Compaction: 100.44 (soft)

Moisture: 7.32 (average wet)

Notes: The compaction readings were in the 90-110 range with a few as high as 130 (pedestrian crossings) and as low as 80. Much depends on the weather. The long-range forecast predicts cool, dry weather, perfect for selective irrigation.
