There will be an Officials' meeting at 12:30 a.m. in the paddock. All NSA Officials are to be on the grounds by 10:00 a.m. All horsemen and officials are invited to have lunch in the horsemen's tent (adjacent to the Paddock) beginning at 11:00 a.m.

ATTENTION JOCKEYS: There will be a mandatory meeting of all jockeys with the Stewards at 12:15 p.m. at the jocks room. ALL RIDERS MUST ATTEND. All jockeys are reminded to check-in with the Clerk of Scales one hour prior to post time for the first race and report his/her engagement(s) and overweight, if any.

ATTENTION HORSEMEN: First race 1:30 p.m. 35 minutes in between all races.

All grooms / stable staff will be required to have credentials to access the grounds on race day. Call the Carolina Cup office (803-432-6513) to make arrangements in advance.

There will be a pre-race vet check performed by Dr. Ronnie Fulmer and Dr. Susannah Kennedy beginning at 7:30 a.m. at the race barn and ending around 10:00 a.m. ALL HORSES NOT ON LASIX MUST BE ON THE GROUNDS 2 HOURS PRIOR TO POST TIME FOR THE FIRST RACE FOR THE PRE-RACE VET CHECK UNLESS EXCUSED BY THE STEWARDS FOR EXTENUATING CIRCUMSTANCES. LASIX HORSES MUST BE ON THE GROUNDS 4 HOURS PRIOR TO POST TIME FOR THEIR SCHEDULED RACE.

THIRD PARTY FUROSEMIDE (SALIX) ADMINISTRATION

Horsemen are reminded that third party administration of furosemide (Salix) is in effect at this race meet. Please refer to the NSA website (nationalsteepechase.com) for complete details of the NSA Medication policy. Contact Dr. Jeff Witwer (803-243-0328).

Foal papers are not required to be on file with the Horse Identifier at the races in claiming races providing the horse can be properly identified; and tattoos or microchips are required for all horses, with a one-time exception providing the horse can be identified by the markings.

CAROLINA CUP - NOTICE TO HORSEMEN CONCERNING NSA MEDICATION POLICY

All trainers running a horse on furosemide (Salix) at the Carolina Cup, that are not stabled in the race barns, must move their horses to the race barns by the prescribed time for Salix administration (4 hours prior to post time) and vet check. Those horses will remain stabled until paddock time for their race. All post-race testing will be done in two stalls of the four-stall barn between Barn B and the Block Barn. The designated stalls face the Block Barn. Please be advised that horsemen will need to make necessary arrangements for buckets and equipment to cool their horses out in this area if being tested. No horse will be allowed to go back to any outer barns: A, C, D, E until completion of testing.

Attention Trainers: By order of the South Carolina State Veterinarian, all racehorses, ponies, donkeys and any other horses entering the Springdale Race Course for the Carolina Cup Races must have the following documents:

Requirements for out-of state horses:

- 1. CVI Certificate of Veterinary Inspection (valid for 30 days) including description, date of negative EIA (Coggins) results, Lab and Accession number; and
- 2. Negative EIA (Coggins) test within 12 months

Requirements for in-state (South Carolina) horses:

- 1. Negative EIA (Coggins) test within 12 months
- These documents may be checked by State Inspectors on race day.

There will be no training on the racecourse or around the perimeter of the racecourse.

Attention Horsemen: All scratches must be made no later than one hour prior to post time for the first race.

Credentials may be picked up at the NSA/Officials Gate on Springdale Drive. This is the ONLY gate for entry where credentials will be available. You will not be granted access from any other gate.

Course Update:

The Springdale Race Course was re-inspected on Monday, March 27 at 8:45 AM.

Compaction: 90 (soft); readings ranged from 80 to 100 throughout the track.

Moisture: 5 (average); readings ranged from 4 (average dry) to 6 (average) throughout the track.

Notes: The course received 1-1/4 inches of rain over the last 24 hours. An additional 1/2 inch of rain is forecast for today. The grass cover is thin in places but smooth throughout.

The Springdale Race Course was inspected on Wednesday, March 22 by Jeff Teter and Toby Edwards.

Turf: The turf is a mixture of Bermuda Grass overseeded with Winter Rye. Though the Bermuda is dormant, there is a very good mat of Bermuda Thatch. The Rye Grass is spotty in some places and non-existent in others.

Smoothness: The course is smooth throughout.

Compaction: 90 (soft); readings ranged from 80 to 100 throughout the track.

Moisture: 5 (average); readings ranged from 4 (average dry) to 6 (average) throughout the track.

Notes: The course was aerated twice before overseeding with Rye grass this fall, then chain-harrowed and cambridge-rolled. Rye seed germinated well, but was subsequently burned out when we had three days of below freezing temperatures over Christmas. The course was sprayed for weed control in late February. Current forecast: Monday, March 27th: 1 - 1-1/2 inches of rain.
