ATTENTION JOCKEYS: There will be a mandatory meeting of all jockeys at 10:45 a.m. at the Stewards Stand. ALL RIDERS MUST ATTEND. All jockeys are reminded to check-in with the Clerk of Scales one hour prior to post time for the first race and report his/her engagement(s) and overweight, if any.

There will be a meeting of officials at the Stewards Stand at 11:00 a.m.

There will be a mandatory pre-race veterinarian exam beginning at 8:00 a.m. with Dr. Celia Goodall. Only horses that pass the pre-race exam will proceed to the Lasix veterinarian.

LASIX HORSES MUST BE ON THE GROUNDS 4 HOURS PRIOR TO POST TIME FOR THEIR SCHEDULED RACE. ALL HORSES MUST BE ON THE GROUNDS 2 HOURS PRIOR TO POST TIME FOR THE FIRST RACE UNLESS EXCUSED BY THE STEWARDS FOR EXTENUATING CIRCUMSTANCES.

THIRD PARTY FUROSEMIDE (SALIX) ADMINISTRATION: Horsemen are reminded that third party administration of furosemide (Salix) is in effect at this race meet. Please refer to the NSA website (nationalsteeplechase.com) for complete details of the NSA Medication policy.

Foal papers are not required to be on file with the Horse Identifier at the races providing the horse can be properly identified; and tattoos or microchips are required for all horses, with a one-time exception providing the horse can be identified by its markings. All scratches must be made no later than one hour prior to post time for the race.

COURSE UPDATE:

The Cheshire racecourse was re-inspected on March 22, 2023 by Brooke Boyer, Phoebe Fisher, and Kathy Neilson.

Compaction: 124 (firm); readings ranged from 110 (good) to 150 (hard).

Moisture: 3.2 (average dry); readings ranged from 2 (dry) to 4 (average dry).

Notes: A third post and rail fence has been added to the stretch. Due to availability of evergreen brush, the groundline of the last fence will be brush and the groundlines of the others will be telephonepoles. Substantial rain is in the forecast over the next three days.

The Cheshire racecourse was inspected on March 15, 2023 by Brooke Boyer and Kathy Neilson.

Turf: Turf consists of fescue.

Smoothness: The course is moderately smooth.

Compaction: 96 (soft); readings ranged from 60 (deep) to 120 (good) throughout.

Moisture: 4.5 (average dry); readings ranged from 2 (dry) to 6 (average); the course is firm, and there is no significant rainfall in the forecast.

Notes: The four post-and-rail fences will have green brush groundlines. The fences range from 3' to 3'3" in height.

Horse trailers will enter the grounds on the Green Valley Road entrance. Horses will be stabled in temporary stabling.

Boxed lunches will be provided for horsemen. The hospitality tent is open to all.

Directions: From Philadelphia: Take Rt. 95 south, past the Blue Route (Rt. 476). Watch for Rt. 322 west. Take Rt. 322 west to Rt. 1 south. Follow Rt. 1 south, crossing Rt. 202. Continue on Rt. 1 south to second Kennett Square exit, Rt. 82 north. Follow Rt. 82 north past Landhope around the circle and through the village of Unionville. Appx. 1 mile N. of village will be Green Valley Road on right. If you get to 2nd stop sign you've gone too far. Go right on Green Valley. The entrance to the course will be through the woods on left.

From Wilmington (Rt. 52 directions): Take Rt. 52 north. Left on Rt. 1 south. Continue on Rt. 1 south to second Kennett Square exit, Rt. 82 north. Follow Rt. 82 north to thru stoplight (Rt. 926) past Landhope around the circle and through the village of Unionville. Appx. 1 mile N. of village will be Green Valley Road on right. If you get to 2nd stop sign you've gone too far. Go right on Green Valley. The entrance to the course will be through the woods on left.

From Wilmington (Rt. 202 directions): Take Rt. 202 north. Left on Rt. 1 south. Continue on Rt. 1 south to second Kennett Square exit, Rt. 82 north. Follow Rt. 82 north to the stoplight (Rt. 926) past Landhope around the circle and through the village of Unionville. Appx. 1 mile N. of village will be Green Valley Road on right. If you get to 2nd stop sign you've gone too far. Go right on Green Valley. The entrance to the course will be through the woods on left.

From Maryland: Take US Rt. 95 north from Baltimore to the Perryville exit (Rts. 222 & 275), just past the toll booth. At light turn right, away from outlet mall. Go back over Rt. 95 through two lights. Continue on Rt. 275 until it dead ends. Turn right onto Rt. 276. Continue on Rt. 276 until you come to Rt. 1. Take Rt. 1 north to Toughkenamon exit Newark Road. Make a left and follow Newark R. until it comes to a T at Route 82 (Doe Run Rd.) Make a right and follow Rt. 82 South for approximately 1 mile. Second road on left will be Green Valley Road. Go left on Green Valley. The entrance to the course will be through the woods on left.

From West Chester (Rt. 52 directions): Take Rt. 52 south to Rt. 926 west. Follow Rt. 926 west toward Rt. 82. Make a right on 82 and follow it past Landhope around the circle and through the village of Unionville. Approximately 1 mile N. of village will be Green Valley Road on right. If you get to 2nd stop sign you've gone too far. Go right on Green Valley. The entrance to the course will be through the woods on left.

From West Chester (Rt. 202 directions): Take Rt. 202 south to Rt. 926 west. Follow Rt. 926 west toward Rt. 82. Make a right on 82 and follow it past Landhope around the circle and through the village of Unionville. Approximately 1 mile N. of village will be Green Valley Road on right. If you get to 2nd stop sign you've gone too far. Go right on Green Valley. The entrance to the course will be through the woods on left.
