Fines will be imposed.

There will be a Mandatory pre-race veterinary examination for all entries at 2:00 p.m. at the Worthington Farms barns by Dr. Rachel Blakey and Dr. Magda Stewart. NSA protocol will be followed. NO BANDAGES of any kind will be permitted for this exam.

There will be an Officials meeting at the Steward's Tower at 3:00 pm.

There will be a mandatory Riders meeting with the Stewards at the paddock at 3:15 p.m.

All entries shall tack at Worthington Farms.

Outriders and entries leave Worthington Farms barn for paddock at 3:20 pm.

No lead ponies are allowed in the Paddock.

All horses must be in paddock by 3:35 pm.

As a convenience to Riders, the Stewards Advisory Committee has instructed the Clerks of Scales to account for a 2 lb allowance for the safety vest upon weighing out. Therefore, all Riders must weigh out at 2 lbs. over their assigned weight, with their safety vest.

Starting at 1:45 pm, there will be a shuttle for Riders between the paddock and the Worthington Farms barn.

In keeping with the 127-year tradition of no commercial activity at our meet, the Maryland Hunt Cup will not permit any type of advertising on a Rider or a horse running in this race.

No dogs will be permitted on the Maryland Hunt Cup course on race day, nor will they be permitted in the stabling area at Worthington Farms. Please leave your dogs at home.

Traffic Pattern Alert:

There will be NO through traffic on Tufton Avenue after 2:00 p.m. All Patron and Subscriber pass holders must access their lots from the West/ Greenspring Avenue side. At 3:00 pm the police will close all entrances to the course and Tufton Avenue.

NSA hang tags will admit cars to the General Parking lot only. Any passes must be obtained prior to race day. No sales will be made on race day. Parking pass required for entry.

Paddock Notes:

There are two sections of the Paddock:

1) Horsemen Section - only Participating Horsemen and certain Officials will be allowed in this section. Wristbands will be provided to Participating Horsemen and those Officials.

2) Subscriber Section - holders of Paddock tickets, current NSA credentials and Press passes will be allowed in this section.

After all Riders are mounted, entries are to be led in numerical order out of the Paddock to the Finish line. The Post Parade will proceed from the Finish line, up the stretch and towards the last fence. There will be a gap prior to the last fence to exit the stretch.

Moisture: 9 (wet): readings ranged from 7-10 (average wet-wet). The entire course has been mowed twice, aerated and Cambridge-rolled. It will be aerated and mowed again the week before the race if needed, for a height of 7-8 inches on race day.

Maryland Hunt Cup Course Report: The Maryland Hunt Cup racecouse was inspected on Wednesday, April 12 and Sunday, April 16 by Liz McKnight and Nancy Roberts.

Turf: The race is run over fair hunting country. The turf is excellent throughout.

Smoothness: The entire course has been aerated and Cambridge-rolled.

Compaction: 90 (soft); readings ranged from 80-110 (soft-good).

Moisture: 9 (wet); readings ranged from 8-10 (average wet-wet).

Notes: The entire course was aerated the week of April 1, mowed April 9-11 and Cambridge-rolled April 15-17 by Bruce Fenwick. A second aeration will be completed, if needed, later this week. The course will be mowed once or twice more to leave a height of 7 inches on race day. Rainstorms on April 16 improved moisture. A bucket of flags will be available during race week at the first road cross- ing for course walkers to mark any issues.
