ATTENTION JOCKEYS: All jockeys are reminded to check in with the Clerk of Scales one hour prior to the time of the first race and report his/her engagement(s) and overweight, if any. There will be a mandatory meeting of all jockeys with the Stewards at 10:45 AM at the Jockey's Tent. ALL RIDERS MUST ATTEND.

THIRD PARTY FUROSEMIDE (LASIX) ADMINISTRATION: Horsemen are reminded that third party administration of furosemide (Lasix) is in effect at his race meet. Please refer to the NSA website (www.nationalsteepchase.com) for complete details of the NSA medication policy. Contact Dr. Jeff Witwer (803-243-0328).

VET EXAM: There will be a mandatory pre-race veterinary jog exam with Dr. Steve White and Dr. Tom Massie. Bandages are not permitted during the examination. LASIX HORSES MUST BE ON THE GROUNDS FOUR (4) HOURS PRIOR TO POST TIME FOR THEIR SCHEDULED RACE. ALL HORSES MUST BE ON THE GROUNDS TWO (2) HOURS PRIOR TO POST TIME FOR THE FIRST RACE UNLESS EXCUSED BY THE STEWARDS FOR EXTENUATING CIRCUMSTANCES.

Foal papers are not required to be on file with the Horse Identifier at the races providing the horse can be properly identified; tattoos and microchips are required for all horses, with a one-time exception providing the horse can be identified by its markings.

All scratches must be made no later than one hour prior to post time for the first race.

The Old Dominion Hounds race course at Ben Venue Farm was inspected on April 4, 2023 by Don Yovanovich.

Compaction: Average was 116.5 (good). A few areas on top of the hills were a bit firmer.

Moisture: Average was 7.68 (average wet). No measurement was lower than 5.5.

Smoothness: Good with a good cover of grass turning green.

Notes: Ben Venue is a working farm and the race course is used the rest of the year as a hay field of orchard grass, fescue and some clover and maintained year round with the races thoughtfully considered. Weather prediction is for some thunder showers late Thursday and early Friday morning. Saturday sunny, with temperatures in the 50's.
