There will be a meeting of Officials at 12:15 p.m. on the first floor of the Stewards' tower.

ATTENTION JOCKEYS: There will be a mandatory meeting of all jockeys with the Stewards at 12:30 p.m. at the Stewards tower. ALL RIDERS MUST ATTEND. All jockeys are reminded to check-in with the Clerk of Scales one hour prior to post time for the first race and report his/her engagement(s) and overweight, if any.

First post for NSA races: 1:30 p.m.  
Horses to be ready to leave for the paddock for first race at 1:10 p.m.

There will be a mandatory pre-race vet check at the barn with Dr. Jaime Minnella and Dr. Morgan Adams starting at 10:30 a.m. LASIX HORSES MUST BE ON THE GROUNDS 4 HOURS PRIOR TO POST TIME FOR THEIR SCHEDULED RACE. ALL HORSES MUST BE ON THE GROUNDS 2 HOURS PRIOR TO POST TIME FOR THE FIRST RACE UNLESS EXCUSED BY THE STEWARDS FOR EXTENUATING CIRCUMSTANCES.

**THIRD PARTY FUROSEMIDE (SALIX) ADMINISTRATION**

Horsemen are reminded that third party administration of furosemide (Salix) is in effect at this race meet. Please refer to the NSA website [nationalsteeplechase.com](http://nationalsteeplechase.com) for complete details of the NSA Medication policy. Contact Dr. Jeff Witwer (803-243-0328).

Foal papers are not required to be on file with the Horse Identifier at the races providing the horse can be properly identified; and tattoos or microchip are required for all horses, with a one-time exception providing the horse can be identified by his/her markings. All scratches must be made no later than one hour prior to post time for the first race.

CREDENTIALS NEEDED: NSA pins will allow admittance to most subscriber areas around the race course, including the paddock. NSA hang tags will gain access to the grounds via Gate 2 on Providence Road (stable area only).

NSA and Horsemen entrance is via Gate 2 off Providence Road closest to Warren Ave.

Note: Warren avenue along the side of the property and to the south of Providence road is a washed out gravel road unsuitable for many vehicles especially horse vans.

Owners, Trainers and Riders with participating horses are invited to the O.T.R. tent by the tower.

Check in next to the O.T.R. tent for credentials for admission to O.T.R. hospitality.

Additional passes for the OTR hospitality can be purchased until Tuesday afternoon at a cost of \$125 per person (max 2 people) from Brooke Pitone (610-388-8383).

**Horse Related:**

Water - Yes (Also 2 wash bays with good water pressure are available adjacent to new stable location).

The Radnor Hunt Races course was inspected on May 15, 2023 by Charles Fitzgerald.

Turf: Turf is in excellent shape, thick and uniform coverage with no bare areas.

Smoothness: The course was recently aerated and was top dressed last fall.

Compaction: Readings ranged from from 82 to 120 (soft - good).

Moisture: Readings ranged from 5 to 6 (average).

Notes: The timber course has been rebuilt with a safety top rail. Fences are 42 inches high, similar in look and height to the old course with a slightly increased lean and more prominent ground line.
