Foal papers are not required to be on file with the Horse Identifier. Tattoos or microchips are required for all horses, with a one-time exception providing the horse can be identified by his/her markings.

LASIX HORSES MUST BE ON THE GROUNDS 4 HOURS PRIOR TO POST TIME FOR THEIR SCHEDULED RACE. ALL HORSES MUST BE ON THE GROUNDS 2 HOURS PRIOR TO POST TIME FOR THE FIRST RACE UNLESS EXCUSED BY THE STEWARDS FOR EXTENUATING CIRCUMSTANCES.

ALL HORSES WILL BE SADDLED IN THE STABLE AREA BEFORE EVERY RACE AND PROCEED TO THE PADDOCK AS A GROUP. THERE WILL BE NO SADDLING IN THE PADDOCK.

Owners: Are invited to the Delaware Derby by Woodford Reserve Tent. All Owners must RSVP to Jill Abbott (302-218-7529) by Wednesday, May 3 as entrance requires separate mailed credentials.

Trainers: Sandwiches and beverages will be available in the Horseman Check-In tent near the Stables.

Riders: Sandwiches and beverages will be available in the Men's and Women's Jockey Tent.

MUST ENTER OFF RT.52/KENNETT PIKE at GATE 5 with NSA hangtag visible on rearview mirror.

The Winterthur racecourse was inspected on April 23, 2023 by Rob Plankinton and Jill Abbott:

Turf: The turf on this course consists of a relatively thick, lush cover of native fescue and "Division One", a mixture of turf fescues, blues, and rye grass that averaged 6" in height and is consistent.

Fertilized in March 2023, aerated in Fall 2022, March 2023 and April 2023, rolled March 2023.

Smoothness: This course has been rolled in March 2023 and the ground is relatively smooth throughout.

Compaction: 89 (Good). Grass cover provides good cushion.

Moisture: 9 (Average wet)

Notes: Eight traditional "stake and bound" timber fences with telephone pole ground base rails serve as the timber course. The 1st fence is five panels wide and the remaining seven fences are four panels wide. At least two of the fences offer only one option for "run around room." However, this concern has not caused any problems in the past.
