Virginia General Preference will be used in filling all races. The preference, in order, will be Virginia Bred, Virginia Sired, Virginia Certified, and all other horses that are stabled or trained in Virginia or owned by Virginians.

Post times for the Colonial Downs jump races will be 12:00 PM (first) and 12:30 PM (second) each Friday during the meet. When there are three jump races, first race post will be 11:30 AM. Colonial jump races are not part of the regular parimutuel racing program and as such will follow all NSA rules and regulations.

All scratches and rider changes must be made by 10:00 AM on Tuesdays.

All horses will be saddled in the barn.

All steeplechase races at Colonial Downs will be started by Harrison Young.

The Colonial Downs course will be set up with 5 flights of National Fences (3 down the back side and 2 on the front side). The first fence in the stretch the last time around will NOT be jumped.

ALL OWNERS, TRAINERS AND RIDERS MUST BE PROPERLY LICENSED WITH THE NSA BEFORE THEY WILL BE ALLOWED TO PARTICIPATE. A LICENSE WITH THE VIRGINIA RACING COMMISSION IS NOT REQUIRED.

# WORKERS COMPENSATION

All Trainers must have a certificate, or other document, evidencing their maintenance of Workers' Compensation Insurance coverage for all their employees, in accordance with Virginia law and Colonial Downs' House Rules, that identifies the insurance carrier, the policy number, and its date of issue and coverage. Trainers shall also furnish Colonial Downs a copy of a notice to their workers' compensation carrier requesting the carrier to notify Colonial Downs if insurance coverage is cancelled. Failure to maintain a current and valid policy will result in eviction from the grounds. A current workers' compensation policy, indicating coverage specific to Virginia, or a signed RELEASE AND ASSUMPTION OF RISK WAIVER form, must accompany stall applications. (Go to www.colonialdowns.com for RELEASE forms.)

## COGGINS TEST, HEALTH CERTIFICATE AND INOCULATIONS

All Horses, including stable ponies, entering the Racetrack grounds must have a health certificate and required vaccinations, which shall include:

- (1) Certificate of veterinary inspection (Health Certificate) within the prior 3 days
  (2) Verification of EEE/WEE/WNV (encephalitides), rabies, and tetanus vaccinations within the prior 12 months;
  (3) Verification of Influenza and Rhinopneumonitis vaccinations within the prior 120 days; and

(4) Verification of Negative Equine Infectious Anemia (Coggins) Test valid through the entire meet. The Coggins test must be attached to the horse's Jockey Club certificate when placed on file in the horse identifier's office. Coggins must be attached to all digital certificates. Horses not current on flu/rhino, need to be vaccinated immediately, and documentation given by the attending vet directly to the VRC Equine Medical Director. Horses without a current vaccination record will not be allowed to enter.

#### TRAINER NOTICES

Trainers must be in their assigned stall(s) no less than 5 hours. prior to post. Also, the trainer shall have a representative available to assist the VRC veterinarian with the pre-race exam. If there is a

problem with your stall please contact the racing department. If you wish to ship in to another trainer's barn you must obtain permission from the stall superintendent.

All horses running at Colonial Downs must be tattooed or microchipped, and be on the grounds five (5) hours prior to post time of their race. Foal papers are NOT required unless papers are needed to properly identify the horse.

#### 150-DAY LAYOFF REPORT FORMS

Entries for horses that have not raced for 150 days or more will NOT be accepted unless the trainer has completed and submitted a Layoff Report Form to Dr. Ada Caruthers, Equine Medical Director (ada.caruthers@vrc.virginia.gov). Forms must be submitted at least 30 days prior to entry, and are valid for 60 days.\* Layoff Reports will be made available at the stable gate, in the Racing Office, in the VHBPA Office, and online at www.colonialdowns.com. The preferred method of submission of the form is to access the VRC Website www.vrc.Virginia.gov, click on "Veterinary Forms and Info" and complete the 150-day layoff report from your phone, tablet or computer. If the horse will race out of town, the Layoff Report Form must be submitted to the jurisdiction where the horse will race. \*This requirement may be waived by the VRC Equine Medical Director. This form does not apply to first time starters.

### **RIDER NOTICES**

All jump riders must ride in a helmet approved by the NSA and use a ProCush Whip. All riders are required to report to the jockeys' room at the HBPA office on the backside no later than two (2) hours before post time for the first race.

The HISA whip rule will be in effect at Colonial Downs, per order of the NSA Stewards Advisory Committee.

Riders, please note that the overgirth, breastplate (or yoke) are not to be included in the assigned weight when weighing out or in. Therefore, these pieces of safety equipment should not be included with your tack weighing out, and must be dropped (along with your helmet and crop) before getting on the scale to weigh in.

# PURSE DISTRIBUTION

All purse monies will be distributed through the NSA Central Bookkeeping System as follows: 60% to the winner, 18% to second, 10% to third and 7% to fourth. A \$1,000 participation incentive will be paid to owners that finish after fourth place.

All trainers will receive \$300 per race regardless of the finish to be paid by the Colonial Downs Bookkeeper.

The NSA will deduct an administrative fee equivalent to 3% of the purse from owners whose horses earn a portion of the purse. Runners Reward applies, with all fees waived for any horse which runs and does not earn a portion of the purse.
