ATTENTION JOCKEYS: All Jockeys must sign a release provided by Steeplechase of Charleston to participate. There will be a meeting with the Stewards and all jockeys with the Stewards at 11:45 a.m. ALL RIDERS MUST ATTEND. All jockeys are reminded to check-in with the Clerk of Scales one hour prior to post time of the first race and report his/her engagement(s) and overweight, if any. SHOWERS WILL BE AVAILABLE ON RACE DAY, PLEASE PROVIDE YOUR OWN TOWEL.

There will be an officials' meeting at 12:00 p.m. at the Stewards Stand.

There will be a mandatory pre-race vet check with Dr. Chris Ernst. Bandages are not permitted during the examination. LASIX HORSES MUST BE ON THE GROUNDS 4 HOURS PRIOR TO POST TIME FOR THEIR SCHEDULED RACE. ALL HORSES MUST BE ON THE GROUNDS 2 HOURS PRIOR TO POST TIME FOR THE FIRST RACE UNLESS EXCUSED BY THE STEWARDS FOR EXTENUATING CIRCUMSTANCES.

THIRD PARTY FUROSEMIDE (SALIX) ADMINISTRATION Horsemen are reminded that third party administration of furosemide (Salix) is in effect at this race meet. Please refer to the NSA's website nationalsteeplechase.com for complete details of the NSA Medication policy.

Attention Horsemen: All scratches must be made no later than one hour prior to post time for the first race. REMINDER: Foal papers are not required to be on file with the Horse Identifier at the races; and tattoos or microchips are required for all horses with a one-time exception provided the horse can be identified by its markings.

- Requirements for out of state horses:

1. CVI - Certificate of Veterinary Inspection (valid for 30 days) including description, date of negative EIA (Coggins) results, Lab and Accession number; and
2. Negative EIA (Coggins) test within 12 months

- Requirements for in-state (South Carolina) horses:

1. Negative EIA (Coggins) test within 12 months

These documents may be checked by State Inspectors on race day.

Turf: A mixture of semi dormant Bermuda and other native grasses. Standing at 5-6in in height with a good cover overall.

Smoothness: Smooth throughout. We have rolled and harrowed regularly.

Compaction: 120-130 Firm. The course was core aerated in mid-October but due to lack of rain, the Course is firmer than we would like. We will core aerate early race week.

Moisture: 1 Dry. October rain fall only at an inch and a quarter with no significant rain fall in the forecast before race day.

Notes: Should we get rain; we will aerate early race week. At the current time, the ground is too firm for the aerator to have any impact in reducing the compaction levels. Due to ground under repair, the second last jump will be removed therefore there will be only 4 jumps per turn of the race course.
