STABLING: NSA horsemen's parking is located at 2605 Butler Road, one mile west of Falls Road. Temporary stabling will be provided free of charge; companion animals must have current Coggins and are to remain in a stall throughout the event.

THIRD PARTY FUROSEMIDE (SALIX) ADMINISTRATION

Horsemen are reminded that third party administration of furosemide (Salix) is in effect at this race meet. Please refer to the NSA's website www.nationalsteeplechase.com for complete details of the NSA Medication policy. Contact Dr. Nick Meitinis for questions (410-365-4255).

Foal papers are not required to be on file with the Horse Identifier at the races providing the horse can be properly identified; and tattoo and/or microchip is required for all horses, with a one-time exception providing the horse can be identified by its markings. All scratches must be made no later than one hour prior to post time for the first race.

A pre-race veterinary exam is required for each entry beginning at 11:00 a.m. at the stable area by Dr. Meghan Delp; Steward(s) will be present for the pre-race veterinary exam. Bandages are not permitted during the examination.

ALL HORSES NOT ON LASIX MUST BE ON THE GROUNDS 2 HOURS PRIOR TO POST TIME FOR THE FIRST RACE FOR THE PRE-RACE VET CHECK UNLESS EXCUSED BY THE STEWARDS FOR EXTENUATING CIRCUMSTANCES. LASIX HORSES MUST BE ON THE GROUNDS 4 HOURS PRIOR TO POST TIME FOR THEIR SCHEDULED RACE.

Scratches are due no later than 1:30 p.m. with the Clerk of Scales, Ed McLaughlin.

There will be a mandatory meeting of all jockeys with the Stewards at 1:15 p.m. at the jockeys' tent. Jockeys, please note that no advertising will be allowed on breeches; jockeys with advertising on their breeches will not be permitted to ride.

Boxed lunches will be provided to race officials and volunteers at the horsemen's stabling area prior to the 1:00 p.m. Stewards' meeting and/or the paddock prior to the 1:30 p.m. Officials' meeting.

The Grand National Race Committee will host a reception for race officials, volunteers, owners, trainers, and jockeys immediately following the last race (approximately 6:00 p.m.) at the horsemen's stabling area at 2605 Butler Road. The Race Committee would like to extend its thanks to Wendy and Ben Griswold's for hosting the post-race reception.

Special Events Medical Services (SEMS) provides field trauma support and works within the parameters of the Maryland Institute for Emergency Medical Services Systems (MIEMSS). Note: SEMS utilizes Gator vehicles specifically modified for field trauma use. A team of qualified physicians is present to supervise medical activities and to perform examinations following a fall.

The Grand National Steeplechase and the Benjamin H. Murray Memorial are run between red and white flags. The Maiden Timber and the Western Run Plate II are run between blue and white flags.
