My Lady's Manor Vet Check Time Change

The mandatory pre-race vet check by Dr. Liz Patternotte and Dr. Ashley Buerkley in the stable area is now between 9:00 a.m. and 11:00 a.m.

Updated Rider Medical Protocol

We are making a couple of changes to the medical program and want to make you all aware. The first is simple, if your horse falls, you will have to get both the medical evaluation and the concussion evaluation. Currently, we leave the concussion evaluation up to the discretion of the doctor covering based on your fall, symptoms and answers to questions. Those that have had the concussion evaluation will notice that it does not take very long, and as long as you clear it, it will not keep you from getting to your next mount.

The second change is because of some concerns after falls and back pain. Over the past 2 years we have had multiple riders who have fallen, complain of back pain, have been cleared to ride and then turn out to have spinal fractures. Fortunately these riders have reached out and gotten evaluated prior to racing again, and therefore have avoided potential serious injury. Moving forward, if you complain of back pain, or have any tenderness over your spine when the doctor evaluates you, you will be stood down for the remainder of that day and required to have x-rays prior to racing again. Please do not take this as a form of punishment, but as concern on our part for your well being. Head and spinal injuries are the two things that can have life altering consequences, and are not worth risking.

We ask that you please be honest with the doc at the races about both head and back injuries/pain. I am always here to help you post injury to get further evaluation and treatment. Please put my cell number in your phones, and text or call at anytime with questions or concerns 410-925-8798.

Purse \$75,000. Hurdle. For Four Year Olds and Upward which have not won over hurdles prior to September 1, 2023 or which have never won three races, other than three-year-old. Four-year-olds, 146 lbs.; older, 150 lbs. Winners, other than maiden, claiming, starter, or three-year-old: 3 lbs. extra for each race won.

Two Miles and Three Furlongs over National Fences.

THE LONESOME GLORY (Grade I) (Hurdle Stakes)

Purse \$150,000. Hurdle Handicap. For Four Year Olds and Upward. Two Miles and One Half over National Fences. Nominations Close Saturday, August 31.

Official Notes:

- Permission for apprentice riders to ride in jump races at Colonial Downs, Saratoga, and Aqueduct may be granted by the Stewards Advisory Committee on a case by case, and race by race basis.
- In all steeplechase races at Colonial Downs, Saratoga, and Aqueduct, the first fence in the stretch will <u>not</u> be jumped on the final circuit; therefore, the last fence down the backside at all venues will be the final fence.
- In all races at Saratoga and Aqueduct, Lasix is prohibited. Also, horses 10 years old and upward are <u>not</u> permitted to run at NYRA racetracks.
- Maidens over jumps are ineligible for steeplechase races at Saratoga and Aqueduct.
- Post times for the Colonial Downs jump races will be 1:30 PM (first), 2:00 PM (second), and 2:30 PM (third). The Colonial jump races are now part of the regular parimutuel racing program and as such will follow all of the standard racetrack protocols.
- Limit of field in the maiden hurdle races at Colonial Downs is 10, with 12 allowed in ratings races and the filly/mare stakes.
- All horses entering the Colonial Downs, Saratoga or Aqueduct racetrack grounds must have proof of health certificate and required vaccinations, and a current negative Coggins test.
