Race 1: Race 1 Chart

#8 I Am Fortunata ran in trainer's silks.

#3 Ice Bar lost rider at the 4th fence. Jockey Sarah Cundith was cleared.

#1 Get Khozy pulled up at the 8th fence (Tired).

#2 Bunker Hill pulled up at the 8th fence (Tired).

#9 Larger Than Life fell at the 8th fence and was euthanized off course. Jockey Ben Ffrench Davis was not cleared.

Prior to the race, #8 I Am Fortunata bolted and jumped a fence on the way to the start. The stewards investigated, found jockey Gerard Galligan not to be at fault, and took no action. #9 Larger Than Life was sent to Griffin Laboratory for necropsy post-event.

Race 2: Race 2 Chart

#4 Isihara was scratched.

#1 Kelmscott was excused from the post parade.

Race 3: Race 3 Chart

#4 Bee Major was scratched.

#5 Secret Soulmate was accompanied to the start by the assistant trainer.

#5 Secret Soulmate fell at the 8th fence but was uninjured. Jockey Jamie Bargary was cleared.

The first start was recalled by the starter. The second start was successful.

#6. The Insider was scratched.

All horses in race 4 were tested pre-race for TCO2.

Race 5: No Actions
