ATTENTION JOCKEYS: There will be a mandatory meeting all jockeys with the stewards at 12:15 p.m. at the Race Tower. **ALL RIDERS MUST ATTEND.** All jockeys are reminded to check-in with the Clerk of Scales one hour prior to post time for the first race and report his/her engagement(s) and overweight, if any.

THIRD PARTY FUROSEMIDE (SALIX) ADMINISTRATION

Horsemen are reminded that third party administration of furosemide (Salix) is in effect at this race meet. Please refer to the NSA website nationalsteeplechase.com for complete details of the NSA Medication policy. Contact Dr. Nicole Swinehart (803-427-4053).

There will be a mandatory pre-race veterinary exam with Dr. Alec Davern. Bandages are not permitted during the examination. Bandages are not permitted during the examination.

ALL HORSES MUST BE ON THE GROUNDS 2 HOURS PRIOR TO POST TIME FOR THE FIRST RACE (IF NOT ON LASIX) FOR THE PRE-RACE VET CHECK UNLESS EXCUSED BY THE STEWARDS FOR EXTENUATING CIRCUMSTANCES. LASIX HORSES MUST BE ON THE GROUNDS 4 HOURS PRIOR TO POST TIME FOR THEIR SCHEDULED RACE.

Foal papers are not required to be on file with the Horse Identifier at the races providing the horse can be properly identified, and tattoos or microchips are required for all horses, with a one-time exception providing the horse can be identified by its markings. All scratches must be made no later than one hour prior to post time for the first race.

All NSA credentials are available for pickup at the Race Tower on race day.

ATTENTION ALL OWNERS, TRAINERS, RIDERS, GROOMS AND OFFICIALS:

Tryon will provide shade tents, snacks, non-alcoholic beverages, and ice at the tower area, stabling area, and jockeys tents. Tryon will also provide a boxed lunch, snacks, and non-alcoholic beverages to all participants associated with the Race Operations including Owners, Riders, Trainers, Grooms, Vets, Farrier, Officials, etc.

Health Documentation Requirements:

The following health documents must accompany each horse(s) upon arrival.

1. Negative Coggins test within 1 year.

2. Out of state horses must have a 30 day interstate health certificate.

Due to equine health concerns we urge all equestrians to please remember and abide by the following bio security measures: Please contact Molly Oakman (828-289-5335) immediately if there are concerns with bio security of fevers exceeding 101.5.

- Take all horses' temperatures daily and immediately report any horse with a temperature above 101.5 degrees Fahrenheit or any signs of respiratory or neurological disease to your veterinarian and/or race director.

- Take the temperature of all horses prior to shipping, and do not bring any febrile horses or horses exposed to fevers of unknown origin to the race meet.

- Avoid mixing of horses where possible, practice equine social distancing. Please consider isolating any new horse(s) introduced to your farm for a minimum of 14 days.

- Avoid sharing items between horses, such as water buckets and hoses.

- Ensure good hygiene and biosecurity at the race and your home farms.

- Strongly recommend your horses are currently vaccinated for influenza and EHV.

- Please take the time to review equine good hygiene practices and impress their importance to your grooms and barn managers in everyday care.

Stabling (temporary): Contact Molly Oakman (828-289-5335) no later than Wednesday.

Early arrivals are allowed to stable at Tryon International Equestrian Center and access to gallop hill will be made available.

Two bags of shavings provided and an ice trailer will be on property and available for horses.

Electrical outlets are available and fans are allowed. Please bring extension cords.
