The Winterthur racecourse was inspected on April 22 by Jill Abbott and Kevin Braun:
The turf on this course consists of a relatively thick, lush cover of native fescue and "Division One", a mixture of turf fescues, blues, and rye grass that averaged 6" in height and is consistent.
Fertilized March 2024, Aerated Fall 2023 and March 2023, Rolled March 2024.

Smoothness: This course has been rolled in March 2024 and the ground is relatively smooth throughout.

Compaction: 104 (GREEN Good). Grass cover provides good cushion.

Moisture: 8 Average wet

Notes: Eight traditional "stake and bound" timber fences with telephone pole ground rails serve as the timber course. The 1st fence is five panels wide and the remaining seven fences are four panels wide. At least two of the fences offer only one option for "run around room". However, this concern has not caused any problems in the past.
