Course Reports

Radnor

Radnor racecourse was inspected on Monday, May 6th by clerk of the course Charlie Fitzgerald

Compaction: 81 Soft.

Moisture: 6 Average.

The course has been aerated twice, is smooth throughout and has a good cover of turf which is a mix of perennial ryegrass, tall fescue and some bluegrass.

Note: The timber course will be the same as last year but with the top rails more firmly attached while still being able to be knocked down. We continue to search for the appropriate breaking point for the safety of horse and rider while still encouraging accurate jumping.
