- Jockeys:** **Mandatory** meeting of all jockeys with the Stewards at 11:15 AM.
Check in with Clerk of Scales by 10:45 AM to report engagement (s) and overweight, if any.
- Pre Race Exam:** Mandatory veterinarian pre-race exam for all horses. Examinations will begin at 9:30 am and end by 11AM. Horses will be called up in race order. Bandages are not permitted during the exam. Horses on Lasix must be on the grounds four (4) hours prior to their scheduled post time. All horses must be on the grounds by 10AM. Unless excused by the Stewards.
- Scratches:** All scratches after 10am Tuesday, Oct 22, must be made no later than 11AM on race day.
- Weighing in Policy:** Winning jockey or any jockey claiming a foul will dismount and weigh in at the Steward Stand. All others will stay mounted and return to the paddock to dismount. These jockeys will weigh in on the same scale they weighed out on.
- Saddling:** ALL HORSES WILL BE SADDLED IN THE BARN.
Horses are to enter the paddock in sequential, saddle cloth numerical order. When leaving the paddock, horses are to be released when entering the course, not in the chute.
- Leaving the Course:** Except for the winner, all other horses and riders must make their way back to the paddock by way of the gallop lane and finish line, and must ride off course into the paddock to meet groom & dismount. DO NOT DISMOUNT or remove tack until you are in the paddock.

Third Party Furosemide (SALIX) Administration:

Horsemen are reminded that third party administration of furosemide (Salix) is in effect at this race meet. Please refer to the NSA's website (nationalsteeplechase.com) for complete details of the NSA Medication policy. Contact Dr. Jeff Witwer (803-243-0328) with questions.

Foal Papers:

No longer required to be on file with the Horse Identifier at the races provided the horse can be properly identified by tattoo or microchip. A one-time exception may be made provided the horse can be identified by its markings.

Health Certificate:

Horses shipping to the International Gold Cup must have a Health Certificate dated within the last 5 days with the following information.

- Originated barn location with status on active or suspect case of Herpes Virus
- Vaccination date for EHV-1 that is dated no less than 7 but no more than 120 days.
- Coggins test conducted within 12 months.
- Rectal Temp of each horse at time of examination

Stabling:

Stalls & one (1) bale of shavings straw will be provided with each entry. Contact TC Williams at 703-843-6385 if you are planning to bring an AE horse as well. Please discard all wraps and supply materials in a trash can, not in the stall along with any other trash generated during the day.

NO OVERNIGHT STABLING PERMITTED.
