**OFFICIAL COMMENTS:** Races historically carded at 2 1/8 will be shortened to 2 miles in 2025. The Officials' meeting and the Jockeys' meeting were held as scheduled. The course was in excellent condition.

Race 1: FOREVER HOPEFUL fell at the 9<sup>th</sup>. Jockey Mel Boucher was cleared to ride.

Race 2: #4 BEYOND REPROACH was scratched. #7 ANYTIME was scratched. There was Stewards' inquiry into the incident at the first fence. After extensive video review there was no change to the order of finish. Jockey Steve Mulqueen was not cleared to ride

Race 3: Change the rider on #6 KING TSUNAMI to Paddy O'Hanlon. LIGHTNING ROD fell at the 7<sup>th</sup>. Jockey Gerard Galligan was cleared to ride.

Race 4: #2 TOO FRIENDLY was chosen for TCO2 testing. #7 WELSHMAN fell at the last. Jockey Bernie Dalton was cleared to ride. Change the rider on JIMMY P to Paddy O'Hanlon.

Race 5: Change the Jockey on Kiyomori to Graham Watters. TOTAL JOY pulled up at the 2<sup>nd</sup> to last. Reported tired. PICKANUMBER pulled up before the finish line. Appeared to be lame and will be placed on the vet's list. #8 COOL JET was a vet scratch and will be placed on the vet's list.

Race 6: Tolaga Bay wore the #5 saddlecloth rather than the #13 saddlecloth.

All horses who fell were cleared to travel home
