Thursday Course Reports

Loudoun: The course will be ready to walk Thursday evening through to Sunday. The Course is smooth and turning green. Compaction: 102 (good) Moisture: 6 (average)

Middleburg: Middleburg had 1/2 inch of rain on Monday night. There has been extreme winds the past two days. Compaction: 90 (soft) Moisture: 1.64 (dry)

Grand National:

Compaction 90-100 (soft) Moisture 7-8 (average wet)

As part of our ongoing efforts to enhance safety, we'll be placing standard foam rolls in front of Dixon's natural hedges this year. We developed a new fixation system to help keep them securely in place, and Dr. Reynolds Cowles provided us with a testing protocol to evaluate its effectiveness. I'm sharing a video of the test for your review and distribution as you see fit. In it, you'll see a 100-pound tractor weight suspended on an 8-foot chain, simulating the type of impact the system is designed to withstand.
