ATTENTION JOCKEYS:There will be a mandatory meeting with all jockeys with the stewards at 11:30 a.m. ALL RIDERS MUST ATTEND. All jockeys are reminded to check-in with Clerk of Scales one hour prior to post time for the first race and report his/her engagement(s) and overweight, if any.

Notice: After 12:00 p.m. NO JOCKEYS WILL BE ABLE TO WALK THE RACE COURSE.

There will be an officials meeting at 12:00 p.m. at the Stewards Stand.

There will be a mandatory veterinarian exam before the races. ALL HORSES NOT ON LASIX MUST BE ON THE GROUNDS 2 HOURS PRIOR TO POST TIME FOR THE FIRST RACE FOR THE PRE-RACE VET CHECK UNLESS EXCUSED BY THE STEWARDS FOR EXTENUATING CIRCUMSTANCES. LASIX HORSES MUST BE ON THE GROUNDS 4 HOURS PRIOR TO POST TIME FOR THEIR SCHEDULED RACE.

THIRD PARTY FUROSEMIDE (SALIX) ADMINISTRATION: Horsemen are reminded that the third party administration of furosemide (Salix) is in effect at this race meet. Please refer to the NSA website (nationalsteepchase.com) for complete details of the NSA Medication policy. Contact Dr. Nicole Swinehart (803)427-4053.

VET EXAM: There will be a mandatory pre-race veterinary jog exam with Dr. Paul Anikis at 9:30 am. Jog goes in race order (Race 1, Race 2, Race 3, etc). Bandages are not permitted during the examination.

LASIX HORSES MUST BE ON THE GROUNDS FOUR (4) HOURS PRIOR TO POST TIME FOR THEIR SCHEDULED RACE. ALL HORSES MUST BE ON THE GROUNDS TWO (2) HOURS PRIOR TO POST TIME FOR THE FIRST RACE UNLESS EXCUSED BY THE STEWARDS FOR EXTENUATING CIRCUMSTANCES.

IMPORTANT: No cars to park in van area. All cars are to park in designated owner/trainer/rider parking only. If cars are parked in the van parking area, they will be towed out immediately. All trucks and trailers must follow the directions of the parking crew. ALL HORSES WILL BE SADDLED IN THE BARN BEFORE EVERY RACE. THERE WILL BE NO SADDLING IN THE PADDOCK. Foal papers are no longer required to be on file with the Horse Identifier providing the horse can be properly identified; tattoo and/or microchip is required for all horses, with a one-time exception providing the horse can be identified by its markings.

All scratches must be made no later than one hour prior to post time for the first race.

Horsemen: As required by the Virginia Department of Agriculture: All horses must be accompanied by a report of an official negative test for equine infectious anemia (coggins test) conducted within the last 12 months. The Certificate must accompany all horses in order to gain access to the races. This requirement will be strictly enforced. Please turn in a copy of your coggins test to the HORSE IDENTIFIER (Wayne VanSant).

NOTICE TO JOCKEYS AND OFFICIALS: There will be food in the hospitality tent. Jockeys park in the old parking lot below the Fred Barn. Follow signs in to van area and take an immediate left.

Schooling will not be permitted before, during or after the races. See Doug Fout for any problems that may arise (540)270-9612.
