ATTENTION JOCKEYS: All jockeys are reminded to check in with the Clerk of Scales one hour prior to the time of the first race and report their engagement(s) and overweight, if any. There will be a mandatory meeting of all jockeys with the Stewards at 10:45 AM at the Jockey's Tent. ALL RIDERS MUST ATTEND.

THIRD PARTY FUROSEMIDE (LASIX) ADMINISTRATION: Horsemen are reminded that third party administration of furosemide (Lasix) is in effect at his race meet. Please refer to the NSA website (www.nationalsteeplechase.com) for complete details of the NSA medication policy. Contact Dr. Tom Massie (540-987-1200).

VET EXAM: There will be a mandatory pre-race veterinary jog exam with Dr. Steve White and Dr. Tom Massie. Bandages are not permitted during the examination. LASIX HORSES MUST BE ON THE GROUNDS FOUR (4) HOURS PRIOR TO POST TIME FOR THEIR SCHEDULED RACE. ALL HORSES MUST BE ON THE GROUNDS TWO (2) HOURS PRIOR TO POST TIME FOR THE FIRST RACE UNLESS EXCUSED BY THE STEWARDS FOR EXTENUATING CIRCUMSTANCES.

Foal papers are not required to be on file with the Horse Identifier at the races providing the horse can be properly identified; tattoos and microchips are required for all horses, with a one-time exception providing the horse can be identified by its markings.

All scratches must be made no later than one hour prior to post time for the first race.

There will no people allowed on the infield of the ODH course except emergency personnel and course crew workers. All trainers, grooms and spectators will be asked to stay beyond the perimeter fence.

- 1. RIDERS: Must walk their courses **before the first race goes to post** and be clear of the course. No one will be allowed on the course after the horses leave the paddock for the first.
- 2. ALL HORSEMEN: No dogs allowed on the course. (Do *not* take your dog on your course walk. Do *not* bring your dog to the paddock.)
- 3. Horsemen are *no longer allowed* to watch from the racecourse hilltop near the paddock. *No one* will be allowed to go through the horse gate from the paddock.

 If your horse needs someone on the shank to get to the start, please arrange with an outrider to pick you up coming out of the saddling enclosure, or see the senior steward at the meet to arrange help.
- 4. Owners, trainers and grooms with horses in the upcoming race will be shepherded up the outside rail to the winner's circle for viewing on the hill at the stewards' stand. You can also watch from along the snow fence that lines the course beyond the wire coming from the paddock.

 Horsemen can choose either place, but no one is allowed on course during the race so choose one or the other.
- 5. The winner will unsaddle and weigh in at the winners' circle/stewards stand/finish line. All other finishers will unsaddle and weigh in at the paddock.
- 6. Horsemen's parking will be between the van parking, NSA barn and the paddock.
- 7. All horsemen, please enter through the van gate closer to Rt. 211.

- -- NSA entries must go into a stall in the NSA tent.
- -- Point to point entries must NOT go in a stall in the NSA tent/must run off the vans.
- 8. Reminder, there's rarely any food for sale at this meet.
- -- For grooms/horsemen, there will be a small tent set up between the NSA stalls and the van parking area with snacks and drinks which will be open all day.
- -- For owners/trainers, there is a hospitality tent behind the stewards' stand with refreshments before and after the races.
- -- For riders, the jocks room area will have snacks and drinks before and during the race day, with barbecue sandwiches after racing.
- -- For all horsemen, it is strongly recommended to bring your own snacks and drinks as well.
- 9. Reminder, there are barely any/no services, food/drinks or fuel once you are beyond Marshall (if you come on Rt. 647) or beyond Warrenton (if you come on Rt. 211.) Stock up before you pass town.
- 10. VERY IMPORTANT if your GPS tries to take a horse van on Grimsley Road (coming from Marshall on Rt. 647/some GPSs send you this way because it is the shortest route), DO NOT DO IT. There is a very steep hill with switchbacks that bigger vans will not be able to make. Instead, take 647 to Rt. 637/South Poes Road (to Rt. 211.)

 A car can come this way, but don't try it with a horse trailer.
- 11. Call Betsy Parker at 540 229 2048 if you need anything on race morning, or anything during race week.

The Old Dominion Hounds racecourse at Ben Venue was inspected on Sunday, March 30,2025 around 11:00 a.m. by Don Yovanovich.

The rolling course has a good cover of grass with a good cushion. The entire course was chained harrowed and no mowing is planned before race day.

There is still a brownish winter color to the grass with the green just starting to appear. The forecast for the week is 1 inch of rain Monday the 31st, then possible showers Thursday, Friday and Saturday before race day. Little rain and some sun should turn the course green.
