On Sunday evening, April 27, 2025, the Great Meadow course for the Virginia Gold Cup meet was inspected by Don Yovanovich. It is exciting to watch a well-planned and properly executed agronomic program at work. Great thanks go to our turf specialists, Logan Freeman and Peter Mayback, as well as Bobby Hilton and his grounds crew at Great Meadow, for the wonderful results on the course.

Mowing at 6 inches started Sunday evening and will continue Monday morning. The new grass growth is evident, with a great green color and lush thickness. Aggressive irrigation has provided the necessary moisture for new growth and good compaction readings. Past trouble areas were treated with soaking hoses, and the results are all positive.

In addition to the irrigation at Great Meadow, the forecast for Northern Virginia indicates some showers Thursday and Friday. The course measurements were very consistent throughout the entire course. Sunday's readings are:

- VRC Licenses:** All owners, trainers, riders and grooms participating in the Virginia Gold Cup races are required to be licensed by the Virginia Racing Commission (VRC).

**Admittance to the barn area is restricted to any individual 15 years or younger.**

VRC Staff will be on-site at the Spring House May 1 & 2 from 9-5 for licensing. All licensing to be completed by 5pm on May 2, 2025. **NO DAY PASSES WILL BE GIVEN TO GROOMS; VRC WILL BE AT THE STABLE FROM 7AM—11AM ON RACE DAY. TWO FORMS OF ID WILL BE REQUIRED TO BE LICENSED.**

### Third Party Furosemide (SALIX) Administration:

Horsemen are reminded that third party administration of furosemide (Salix) is in effect at this race meet. Please refer to the NSA's website ([nationalsteeplechase.com](http://nationalsteeplechase.com)) for complete details of the NSA Medication policy. Contact Dr. Nicole Swinehart (803) 427-4053 with questions.

### Saddling:

ALL HORSES WILL BE SADDLED IN THE BARN BEFORE EACH RACE ~ NO SADDLING IN THE PADDOCK. Horses will be led to the paddock TOGETHER before each race. The trainer or their licensed designate will be responsible for transporting the tack after weighing out back to the barn for saddling. Jockeys are not allowed in the stabling area. If trainers have multiple horses in a race or horses in back-to-back races, please make appropriate plans as it is imperative to stay on schedule.

### Foal Papers:

No longer required to be on file with the Horse Identifier at the races provided the horse can be properly identified by tattoo or microchip. A one-time exception may be made provided the horse can be identified by its markings.

### Scratches:

All scratches after 10am Wednesday, May 1, must be made no later than 11AM on race day.

### Health Certificate:

Horses shipping to the Virginia Gold Cup must have a Health Certificate dated within the last 5 days with the following information.

- Originated barn location with status on active or suspect case of Herpes Virus
- Vaccination date for EHV-1 that is dated no less than 7 but no more than 120 days.
- Coggins test conducted within 12 months.

### Stabling:

Stalls & a bale of straw will be provided with each entry. Contact TC Williams at 703-843-6385 if you are planning to bring an AE horse as well. Please discard all wraps and supply materials in a **trash can**, not in the stall along with any other trash generated during the day.

### Schooling:

NO SCHOOLING ON THE COURSE RACE WEEK. The course will be available for walking on Thursday, May 1, 2025 beginning at 11am.

### Refreshments:

Grab & Go breakfast and lunch will be available in the barn area for all trainers and grooms along with cold beverages.

### Pets:

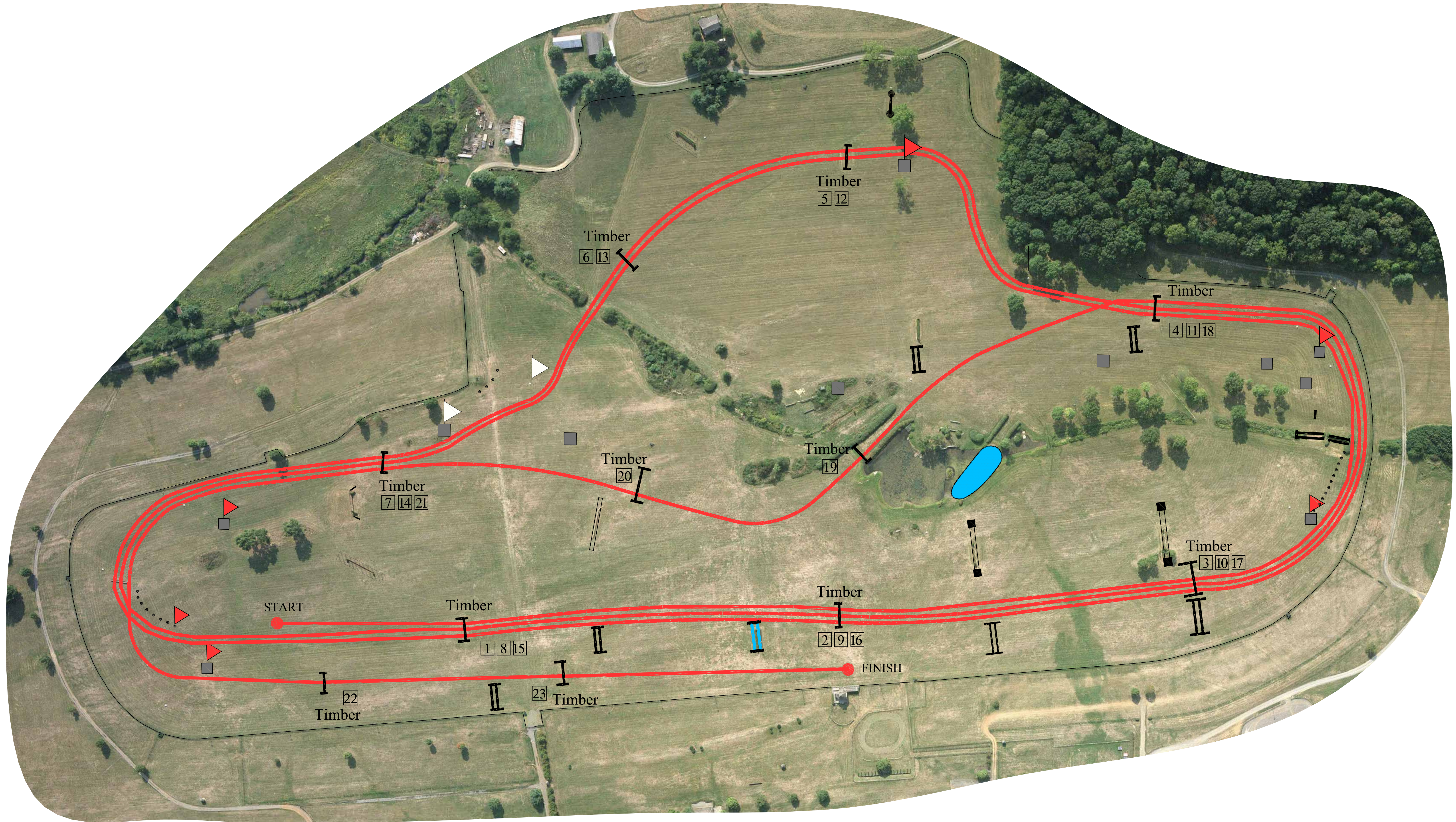

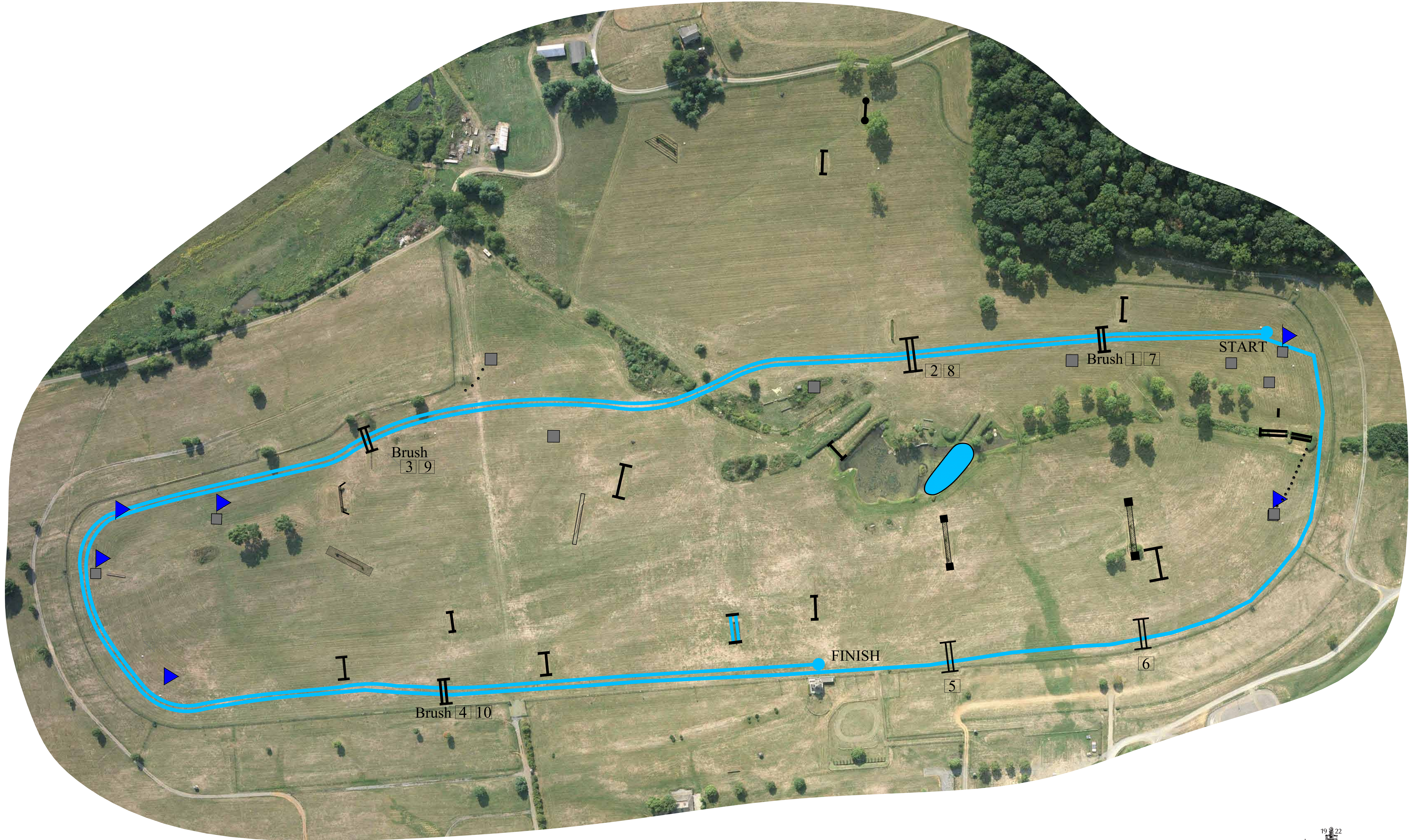

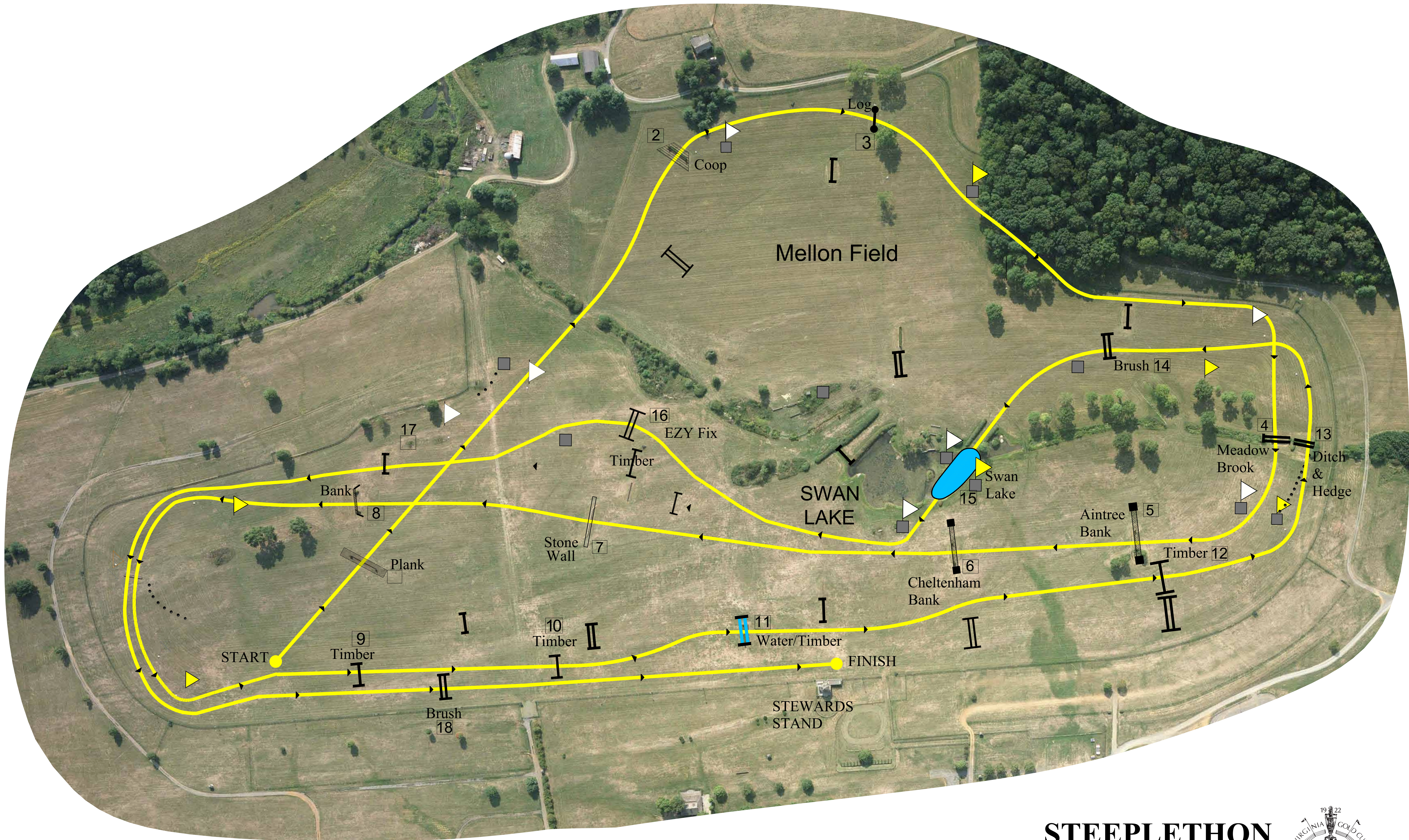
