

By order of the Stewards Advisory Committee

The NSA Stewards Advisory Committee, following a referral from the Stewards of the Radnor Hunt Races held on May 17, 2025, conducted a telephonic hearing with trainer Sandra Webb on Tuesday, May 20 at 2:00 p.m., to discuss a rule violation at Radnor Hunt Races that resulted in the scratching of her five intended runners. Through search discovery by the NSA Safety Steward, a needle and syringe were found in the truck (attached to trailer) of the trainer, in violation of NSA Rule 9.2. Forbidden Practices A. "No person other than a veterinarian described in Rules 5.16, 5.17 or 5.18 shall have in their possession on Association Grounds, during the Race Period, any hypodermic needle, syringe, dose syringe, applicator, or similar device of any type or nature." Trainer Sandra Webb is hereby fined \$2,000 for the violation.

The NSA Stewards Advisory Committee, following a referral from the Stewards of the Radnor Hunt Races held on May 17, 2025, conducted a telephonic hearing with trainer Jack Fisher on Tuesday, May 20 at 2:30 p.m., to discuss a rule violation at Radnor Hunt Races that resulted in the scratching of his two intended runners. Through search discovery by the NSA Safety Steward, a sealed bottle of Banamine was found in the truck (attached to trailer) of the trainer, in violation of NSA Rule 9.1. Forbidden Substances B. "Any trainer or person subject to these Rules who possesses, administers, attempt to administer, instructs, aids, conspires with another to administer, or employs anyone who administers or attempts to administer a forbidden substance to a horse competing at a sanctioned race meet shall be subject to the penalties provided under these Rules." Trainer Jack Fisher is hereby fined \$2,000 for the violation.
