**FIRST RACE
(Maiden Flat)**

Purse \$30,000. For Maidens, Three-Year-Olds and Upward. Three-year-olds, 142 lbs.; older, 148 lbs. Entry fee \$300; \$300 additional if not scratched on time Tuesday; \$300 additional to start.
One Mile and One Half on the Turf.

**SECOND RACE
(Filly/Mare Maiden Flat)**

Purse \$30,000. For Maiden Fillies/Mares, Three-Year-Olds and Upward. Three-year-olds, 142 lbs.; older, 148 lbs. Entry fee \$300; \$300 additional if not scratched on time Tuesday; \$300 additional to start.
One Mile and One Half on the Turf.

**THIRD RACE
(Starter Allowance Flat)**

Purse \$20,000. For Three-Year-Olds and Upward which have started for a claiming price of \$16,000 or less in the last three flat starts. Three-year-olds, 144 lbs.; older, 150 lbs. Non-winners of a race in 2025, allowed 3 lbs.; of a race in 2024-2025, allowed 6 lbs. Entry fee \$200; \$200 additional if not scratched on time Tuesday; \$200 additional to start.
One Mile and One Half on the Turf.

**FOURTH RACE
(Starter Allowance Flat)**

Purse \$20,000. For Fillies/Mares, Three-Year-Olds and Upward which have started for a claiming price of \$16,000 or less in the last three flat starts. Three-year-olds, 144 lbs.; older, 150 lbs. Non-winners of a race in 2025, allowed 3 lbs.; of a race in 2024-2025, allowed 6 lbs. Entry fee \$200; \$200 additional if not scratched on time Tuesday; \$200 additional to start.
One Mile and One Half on the Turf.

**FIFTH RACE
(Flat Race for Jumpers)**

Purse \$25,000. For Four-Year-Olds and Upward which have started over jumps. Four-year-olds, 150 lbs.; older, 154 lbs. Entry fee \$250; \$250 additional if not scratched on time Tuesday; \$250 additional to start.
One Mile and One Half on the Turf.

The race committee intends to split this race with a \$25,000 purse in each division.

These races are sanctioned by the National Steeplechase Association and governed by the Rules and Regulations of the Maryland Racing Commission.

Permanent stabling. Straw provided. For overnight stabling please contact Joanie Morris about timing of arrival.

Limit of field eight (8) horses in all races. Flag start. No starting gate.

Purses will be distributed by the NSA as follows: 60% to first; 18% to second; 10% to third; 7% to fourth; and 5% to fifth. Runners reward applies and all entry fees will be waived for any horse that runs and does not earn a portion of the purse.
