Foal papers are not required to be on file with the Horse Identifier at the races providing the horse can be properly identified; and tattoos or microchip are required for all horses, with a one-time exception providing the horse can be identified by his/her markings. All scratches must be made no later than one hour prior to post time for the first race.

All Owners, Trainers, Assistant Trainers, Jockeys and Grooms participating in the two jump races at Laurel Park on June 15 are required to be licensed by the Maryland Department of Labor. Parking/Access Notes

To access Stable Parking, please use Entrance 3 and follow signs to parking areas by the stables on the far side of the course: 4640 Telegraph Rd., Elkton, MD 21921

There will also be Horsemens Parking via Entrance 2, closer to the main pedestrian entrance, paddock and hospitality area. That address is 4600 Telegraph Rd., Elkton, MD 21921 but it is all the same property. Your NSA Hangtag will get you into that lot. If you need a stable parking pass, email Joanie Morris at joanie@maryland5star.us. Shuttles will be available to take horsemen back and forth from stabling to the paddock area throughout the day. Absolutely no vehicles other than emergency vehicles are allowed through the infield.

Two VIP hospitality tickets per horse will be allocated, and each jockey will be allocated one as well. Hospitality tent is near the paddock and finish line area.

Two bales of straw will be provided per horse. Shavings can be facilitated, but bear in mind the facility policy is straw only and shavings will result in a charge to the race meet. Smoothness: Perfectly smooth, no defects

Compaction: Longchamp Penetrometer rating of 2.1 cm average, within GOOD range per HISA standards. VST (Vienna Surface Tester) rating of 8.3 Going (Good/Firm) with a course variability rating of 17.0 (Average). All VST data is processed utilizing Flat Racecourse Ground Measurement Data Standards established by RACES (Research and Consultancy in Equine Surfaces) in England. This data set is also being utilized domestically by the Racing Surfaces Testing Laboratory.

Moisture: Tested with FieldScout TDR 350 moisture meter. Course average was 21% VWC (volumetric water content) - falls within GOOD range per RACES standards.

Notes: Height of cut is being raised to 5"+ for race day.

Racing Surfaces Testing Lab will be performing complete track analysis testing on 8/25. Another VST/Penetrometer/TDR350 testing will be performed by Boekholder & Associates on afternoon of 8/28. Final Going will be tested Saturday morning 8/30 by Boekholder & Associates around 8:00 am with Clerk of the Course, Steward and Maryland Racing Commission representatives in attendance.

So far, track is in excellent condition. Depending upon results of tests performed this week, track may be either deep tine aerated or Aerway aerated to loosen up lower level stiffness and firmness if required.

Track crossing sod areas (Turn 3 and Frontstretch) are receiving spot treatments of extra hand applied irrigation, aeration and extra fertilizer to reduce the surface difference between those areas and the rest of the track.
