ATTENTION JOCKEYS: There will be a mandatory meeting of all jockeys with the Stewards at 11:20 a.m. at the jockeys room. ALL RIDERS MUST ATTEND. Jockeys are reminded to check-in with the Clerk of Scales one hour prior to post time of the first race and report his/her engagement(s) and overweight, if any. NOTE: smoking and/or vaping is prohibited in the barn area and jockeys' quarters.

There will be an Official's Meeting at the Judge's Stand at 11:30 a.m.

There will be a mandatory pre-race veterinary exam with Dr. Rebecca Kramer and Dr. Reynolds Cowles.
 THIRD PARTY FUROSEMIDE (LASIX) ADMINISTRATION: Horsemen are reminded that third party administration of furosemide (Lasix) is in effect at his race meet. Please refer to the NSA website (www.nationalsteeplechase.com) for complete details of the NSA medication policy.

LASIX HORSES MUST BE ON THE GROUNDS FOUR (4) HOURS PRIOR TO POST TIME FOR THEIR SCHEDULED RACE. ALL HORSES MUST BE ON THE GROUNDS TWO (2) HOURS PRIOR TO POST TIME FOR THE FIRST RACE UNLESS EXCUSED BY THE STEWARDS FOR EXTENUATING CIRCUMSTANCES.

Foal papers are not required to be on file with the Horse Identifier at the races providing the horse can be properly identified; and tattoos or microchips are required for all horses, with a one-time exception providing the horse can be identified by its markings. All scratches must be made no later than one hour prior to post time for the first race.

The average COMPACTION IS 121.3
 The average MOISTURE IS 7.7

We tested 30 separate areas of the course. Conditions are dry but significant rain is forecasted this Wednesday and Thursday. Since the last testing we have run an Agrivator over the course and that has been very impactful in loosening the top layer of soil and grass. The course looks very consistent given the dry conditions. Volunteers will walk the course on Tuesday to check for debris, divots or other potential hazards.

We will continue to share all of our work and their results with the NSA in real time in the coming weeks. We intend to be 100% transparent with all of our findings.
