COLONIAL CUP - NOTICE TO HORSEMEN CONCERNING NEW NSA MEDICATION POLICY

All trainers running a horse on furosemide (Salix) at the Colonial Cup, that are not stabled in the race barns, must move their horses to the race barns by the prescribed time for Salix administration (4 hours prior to post time) and vet check. Those horses will remain stabled until paddock time for their race. No horse will be allowed to go back to any outer barns: A, C, D, E until completion of testing.

Foal Papers:

No longer required to be on file with the Horse Identifier at the races provided the horse can be properly identified by tattoo or microchip. A one-time exception may be made provided the horse can be identified by its markings.

Turf: The turf is a mixture of Bermuda grass overseeded with Perennial rye on September 26th, 2025. Though the Bermuda is dormant, there is a very good mat of Bermuda thatch. The rye grass has germinated at 80%+ and is a height of 4 inches. There are some browner areas after two nights of hard freeze this week.

Smoothness: The course is smooth throughout.

Compaction: 85 - 90 throughout the track. Average 90 soft.

Moisture: Readings of 3-4 throughout the course: average. The irrigation will be run to hold the readings around 3.

Notes: The course has been aerated and cambridge rolled regularly throughout the summer season. The course has also been fertilized and weed control applied at the appropriate times throughout the season. It was also top dressed in the late spring.

Turf: The turf is a mixture of Bermuda grass overseeded with Perennial rye on September 26th, 2025. Due to no irrigation, there is less germination of the rye on the flat track. However, the dormant Bermuda has a great cover throughout.

Compaction: Constant compaction readings at 115 throughout. Good.

Moisture: Readings of 2-3 throughout the course.

Follow US 521 (Broad Street) through town and turn left onto Liberty Hill Road/ Highway 97. In one mile turn left on Springdale Dr. and the NSA/Officials Gate will be approx ½ mile on the left.



Carolina Cup Racing Association Horsemen's Credentials and Luncheon Tent Tickets

The Colonial Cup will give access to the Champions Club Luncheon Tent for participating Owners, Trainers and Officials on the day of the races. CCRA will provide lunch and full bar. Owners and Trainers with horses running on the day will need Champion's Club tickets to access this tent. The NSA Awards Dinner will take place at 6pm on Sunday November 23rd after the races. Each Owner and Trainer must contact the Carolina Cup office (803-432-6513 or eliza@carolinacup.org) before noon on Tuesday, November 18 to provide name(s) for their credentials to be held at the NSA/ Officials Gate on Springdale Dr or picked up PRIOR to 4pm on Saturday, November 22th at the CCRA office, 200 Knights Hill Rd. The office will not be open on Sunday.

The Colonial Cup will provide up to 2 horseman lanyards per single owner. Multi-owner partnerships and/or syndicates will receive up to 4 horseman's lanyards. NSA pins and parking hang tags will be accepted on the day, but as General Admission ONLY. The cost to access the Champions Club Tent for any NSA member that does not have a horse running in the Colonial Cup is \$183.75 per person.
