- Jockeys:** ATTENTION JOCKEYS: There will be a mandatory meeting of all jockeys with the Stewards at 12:15 PM at the jocks room. ALL RIDERS MUST ATTEND. All jockeys are reminded to check-in with the Clerk of Scales one hour prior to post time for the first race and report his/her engagement(s) and overweight, if any. Showers are available in both the male and female Jocks Room. Shower towels are **NOT** provided.
- Race Officials:** There will be an Officials' meeting at 12:30 p.m. in the paddock. All NSA Officials are to be on the grounds by 10:00 AM. All participating horsemen and officials are invited to have lunch in the Horsemen's Pavilion (adjacent to the Paddock) beginning at 11:00 a.m.
- Pre Race Exam:** Mandatory veterinarian pre-race exam for all horses at the race barn performed by Dr. Ronnie Fulmer, DVM, Dr. Brittland Hughes, DVM, and Dr. Susannah Kennedy, BVMS, MARCVS. Examinations will begin at 7:30 AM and end by noon. All horses not on Lasix must be on the grounds 2 hours prior to the first race post time for the pre-race vet check, unless excused by the stewards for extenuating circumstances. Lasix Horses must be on the grounds 4 hours prior to post time for their scheduled race.

CAROLINA CUP - NOTICE TO HORSEMEN CONCERNING NEW NSA MEDICATION POLICY

All trainers running a horse on furosemide (Salix) at the Carolina Cup, that are not stabled in the race barns, must move their horses to the race barns by the prescribed time for Salix administration (4 hours prior to first post time) and vet check. Those horses will remain stabled until paddock time for their race. No horse will be allowed to go back to any outer barns: A, C, D, E until completion of testing.

Foal Papers:

No longer required to be on file with the Horse Identifier at the races, provided the horse can be properly identified by tattoo or microchip. A one-time exception may be made, provided the horse can be identified by its markings.

Trainers:

ATTENTION TRAINERS: By order of the South Carolina State Veterinarian, all racehorses, ponies, donkeys, and any other horses entering the Springdale Race Course for the Carolina Cup Races must have the following documents:

Requirements for out-of-state horses:

1. CVI - Certificate of Veterinary Inspection (valid for 30 days), including description, date of negative EIA (Coggins) results, Lab and Accession number; and
2. Negative EIA (Coggins) test within 12 months

Requirements for in-state (South Carolina) horses:

1. Negative EIA (Coggins) test within 12 months

Race Credentials:

All participating owners, trainers, jockeys, and grooms are encouraged to pick up Carolina Cup credentials from the Carolina Cup Racing Office PRIOR to 4 PM on Friday, March 27. The office will not be open on Saturday.

Credentials may be picked up at the NSA/Officials Gate - 2660 Springdale Dr. This is the **ONLY** gate for entry where credentials will be available. You will not be granted access from any other gate.

Each Owner and Trainer must contact the Carolina Cup office [(803-432-6513) or eliza@carolinacup.org] before noon on Tuesday, March 24th, to provide name(s) for their credentials to be held at the NSA/Officials Gate on Springdale Dr or picked up PRIOR to 4 PM on Friday, March 27, at the CCRA office, 200 Knights Hill Rd. The office will not be open on Saturday. Anyone wearing a Carolina Cup owner, trainer, or jockey lanyard may use boxes H 1-6 in the Grandstand.

The Carolina Cup will provide up to 2 owner lanyards per single owner. Multi-owner partnerships and/or syndicates will receive up to 4 owner lanyards. NSA pins and parking hangtags will be accepted on the day, but as General Admission ONLY. The cost to access the Horsemen's Pavilion for any NSA member that does not have a horse running in the Carolina Cup is **\$100** per person. 2026 Carolina Cup Overnight Information

Course Inspection: The Springdale Race Course was inspected on March 18, 2026, at 1:00 PM by Toby Edwards and Eliza Edwards.

[Jump Track]: Fully Irrigated

Turf: The turf is a mixture of Bermuda grass overseeded with Perennial rye. The Bermuda is starting to green up, and overall, we have a good cover of rye grass. Although due to the exceptionally cold winter this year, we do have some browner areas around the race course, particularly the final turn.

Smoothness: The course is smooth throughout.

Compaction: 85 - 95 throughout the track. Average 90 soft.

Moisture: Readings of 3-4 throughout the course: average. The irrigation will be run to hold the readings around 3.

Notes: The course was cambridge rolled and harrowed a number of times after the 2025 Colonial Cup Races. The course has also been fertilized and top-dressed since the Colonial Cup Races. In some areas, the top dressing sand is still visible.

[Flat Track]: No Irrigation

Turf: The turf is a mixture of Bermuda grass overseeded with Perennial rye last fall. Due to no irrigation, there is less germination of the rye on the flat track. However, the semi-dormant Bermuda has a great cover throughout.

Smoothness: The course is smooth throughout.

Compaction: Constant compaction readings at 115 throughout. Good.

Moisture: Readings of 2-3 throughout the course.

Additional Info: Springdale Race Course now has an Ambient weather station located 100 ft off the race course on the clubhouse turn. Trainers can download the app from the App Store/Play Store for real-time weather updates. Our station's name is "Springdale." Please see the link.
