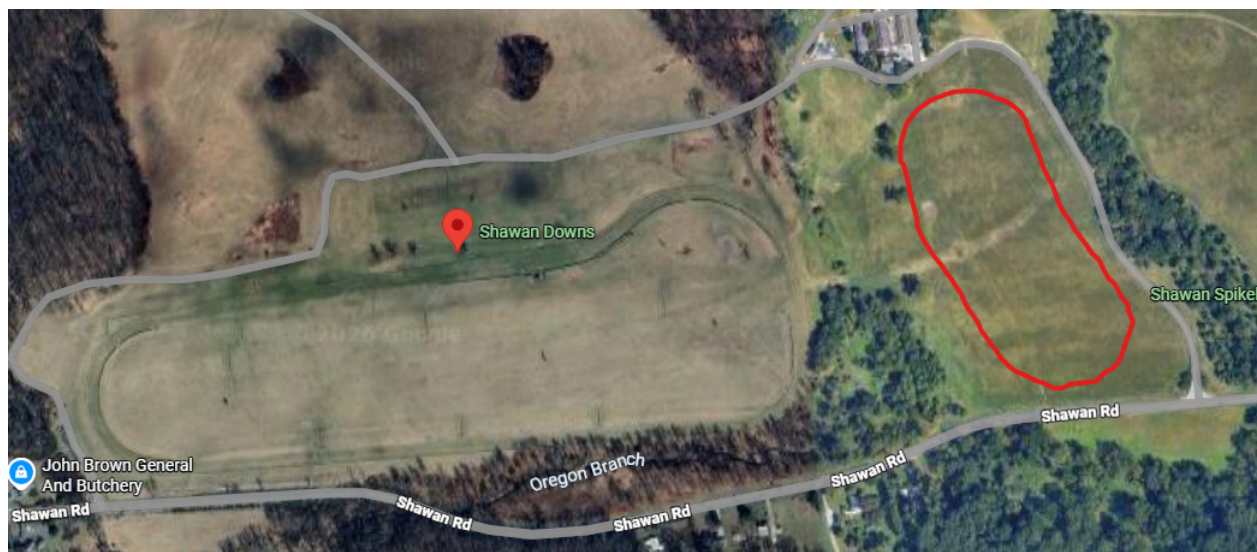

Course:

- To give horses and horsemen the best ground, we will utilize the field highlighted below. This turf has very little traffic throughout the year and is in great condition.
 - o This will also limit traffic on the main course following the Pt. to Pt. to preserve ground for the Fall races
- 4 hurdles will be placed, two down each long side, enabling riders to go twice around if desired and school 8 hurdles



Course Reports

Cheshire:

Compaction: 85 range 70-110 (Soft)

Moisture 7.3 4-9 (Average wet)

Carolina Cup:

Compaction: Constant compaction readings at 115 throughout. Good.

Moisture: Readings of 2-3 throughout the course.

Old Dominion:

Inspection Date: Thursday, March 26

Course: The fescue turf has a good, consistent standing crop. Moisture readings and compaction levels vary more across the jump course than on the flat course.

Compaction: average is 103 but ranged between 95 and 110 (Good)

Moisture: average is 6.6 (Average-average wet)
