All volunteers and officials must be on site by 10:00 am.
There will be a mandatory meeting at 11:15 at the Tower for all Officials. Lunch will be available from 10:45 in the OTR luncheon tent.

Attention Jockeys: There will be a mandatory meeting of all jockeys with the Stewards at 11:30 by the jockey tents in the OTR area. All riders must attend. Showers are available at the jockey tents for both male and female riders. Towels are provided. Jockeys are reminded that they must walk the course prior to the jockey meeting. No pets allowed on grounds.

Grooms: Coffee, breakfast and lunch will be provided at the barn.

There will be a mandatory pre-race veterinarian exam with Dr. Guinta, Dr. Beadle, Dr. Bain, Dr. Obermeyer, and Dr. Alyson Ainsworth. Exams will start at 8 am for first race horses. Bandages are not permitted during the examination.

LASIX HORSES MUST BE ON THE GROUNDS 4 HOURS PRIOR TO POST TIME FOR THEIR SCHEDULED RACE. ALL HORSES MUST BE ON THE GROUNDS 2 HOURS PRIOR TO POST TIME FOR THE FIRST RACE UNLESS EXCUSED BY THE STEWARDS FOR EXTENUATING CIRCUMSTANCES.

THIRD PARTY FUROSEMIDE (SALIX) ADMINISTRATION

Horsemen are reminded that third party administration of furosemide (Salix) is in effect at this race meet. Please refer to the 2026 NSA website for complete details of the NSA Medication policy. Contact , Dr. Jeff Witwer (803) 243-0328

Foal papers are not required to be on file with the Horse Identifier at the races providing the horse can be properly identified; and tattoos or microchips are required for all horses, with a one-time exception providing the horse can be identified by his/her markings. All scratches must be made no later than one hour prior to post time for the first race.

Course Report:

Course Report: Monday, 4/20

Justin Wiley and Reynolds Cowles re-examined the course today at 11 am. Turf height is 8 inches and will be cut again to maintain the desired 6-7 inch height. The turf is green and lush. The racing surfaces are smooth, except for a few rough spots down the back hill. The course has been areated several times this spring. Irrigation has been constant over the last 3 weeks and will continue until fences are set. We had showers yesterday that added to the moisture.

Compaction was measured with both the Longchamp penetrometer and the older Lange penetrometer.

At Foxfield the Longchamp penetrometer averaged good. Moisture was 24.8% - good. The Lange penetrometer averaged 97.7. The Timber course was good with 25% moisture.

We would expect the course to be good on race day.
