**THIRD-PARTY FUROSEMIDE (SALIX) ADMINISTRATION**

Horsemen are reminded that third-party administration of furosemide (Salix) is in effect at this race meet. Please refer to the NSA's website [www.nationalsteeplechase.com](http://www.nationalsteeplechase.com) for complete details of the NSA medication policy. Contact Dr. Alex Dias for questions (304) 279-3972.

Foal papers are not required to be on file with the Horse Identifier at the races providing the horse can be properly identified; tattoo and/or microchip is required for all horses, with a one-time exception providing the horse can be identified by its markings. All scratches must be made no later than one hour prior to post time for the first race.

A pre-race veterinary exam is required for each entry beginning at 11:00 a.m. at the stable area by Drs. Brooke Harper and Meghan Delp; Steward(s) will be present for the pre-race veterinary exams. Bandages are not permitted during the examination.

**ALL HORSES NOT ON LASIX MUST BE ON THE GROUNDS 2 HOURS PRIOR TO POST TIME FOR THE FIRST RACE FOR THE PRE-RACE VET CHECK UNLESS EXCUSED BY THE STEWARDS FOR EXTENUATING CIRCUMSTANCES. LASIX HORSES MUST BE ON THE GROUNDS 4 HOURS PRIOR TO POST TIME FOR THEIR SCHEDULED RACE.**

Scratches are due no later than 1:30 p.m. with the Clerk of Scales, Ed McLaughlin.

There will be a mandatory meeting of all jockeys with the Stewards at 1:15 p.m. at the jockeys' tent. Jockeys, please note that no advertising will be allowed on breeches; jockeys with advertising on their breeches will not be permitted to ride.

Boxed lunches will be provided to horsemen, race officials, and volunteers at the horsemen's stabling area at approximately 11:30 AM and to race officials and volunteers in the paddock prior to the 1:30 PM officials' meeting.

The Grand National Race Committee will host a reception for race officials, volunteers, owners, trainers, and jockeys immediately following the last race (approximately 5:00 p.m.). The reception will be held at the Chestnut Contracting hospitality tent, aside the 17th Grand National fence. The Race Committee would like to extend its thanks to Chestnut Contracting LLC and Redford Excavating LLC for hosting the reception.

Special Events Medical Services (SEMS) provides field trauma support and works within the parameters of the Maryland Institute for Emergency Medical Services Systems (MIEMSS). Note: SEMS utilizes Gator vehicles specifically modified for field trauma use. A team of qualified physicians is present to supervise medical activities and to perform examinations following a fall.

The Grand National Steeplechase and the Benjamin H. Murray Memorial are run between red and white flags. The Maiden Timber and the Western Run Plate II are run between blue and white flags.

Printed course maps for both the Grand National Steeplechase / Benjamin H. Murray Memorial course and the Maiden Timber / Western Run Plate course are available on top of the wellhead in front of the yellow barn at 2605 Butler Road for jockeys that wish to walk the course in advance.

Attention horseman: Please bring fans on Saturday as the weather is forecasted to be in the 80's. Generators will be provided.
