The Iroquois course was inspected Sunday, May 3 by Ted Thompson, clerk of the course, and Zach Lovett, course superintendent.

The turf consists of a thatch of Bermuda grass over seeded with Perennial GQ rye grass. The grass is thick and consistent throughout.

The course has been Cambridge rolled and core aerated several times over the winter and spring. The ground is smooth throughout.

We have taken daily compaction readings for the last two weeks with all readings registering in the Good range. The weather forecast for the week includes a high likelihood of rain on Wednesday. It is our intention to produce ground on the kind side of Good on race day consistent with course conditions from last year.

Due to the recent EHV outbreaks, there will be increased scrutiny on horses shipping into the Iroquois grounds. ALL out of state horses must have a signed veterinary health certificate within 7 days. In state horses do not require a health certificate, but trainers are asked to please take rectal temperatures and record them before shipping onto Association Grounds, this is the recommendation of the State Veterinarian. Safety Steward Keith O'Brien will be in the barn area to check temperature logs and health certificates on arrival. Furthermore, once on Association Grounds, horsemen are asked to collect temperatures daily. Log sheets will be provided upon arrival. We appreciate everyone's cooperation and effort to ensure good biosecurity to protect our horse population.

## Race Day Schedule & Procedures

- **Arrival Times**
  - **Per the NSA policy, all horses participating in the Iroquois Steeplechase must be on the Iroquois Steeplechase grounds, and checked in at the stable area with the safety steward no later than 1:00 pm (cst) on Friday, May 8, 2026.** This is 24 hours prior to post time of the first race on Saturday. There will be no exceptions to this order and tardiness to the grounds may result in a scratch by the NSA Stewards. Vans/Vehicles and tack boxes will be subject to search per the NSA Rules Of Racing while on the Iroquois Steeplechase grounds during the race period, 24 hours before post time for the first race on Saturday.
- **Time Between Races:** Approx. 40 minutes
- **Saddling Procedure:**
  - All horses must be saddled in the barn for every race.
  - Announcements will be made in the barn for saddling and paddock times.
  - Horses proceed to the paddock together in numerical order.
  - Shuttles provided between barn and racecourse for all owners, trainers and riders.
- **Stabling:**
  - Permanent & temporary stalls with shavings; straw available by advance request only (by 8 a.m., Tuesday, May 5).
  - Stalls will be assigned by the Iroquois Steeplechase. No change in assignment without approval from Marianne Byrd in the race office, no exceptions.
  - Veterinary & farrier assistance: On call Wed–Fri, on site Sat.
  - Cooling fans, water and ice available on the racecourse on Saturday.

  - Night Watch will be in the barns 8pm to 6am. All stall cards must be filled out with emergency contact information.

## Health & Entry Requirements

- **Out-of-State Horses:**
  - Certificate of Veterinary Inspection (CVI, valid 30 days) with description, negative EIA (Coggins) results, lab, and accession number; Vaccination date for EHV-1 that is dated no less than 30 but no more than 120 days
  - Negative EIA (Coggins) test within 12 months
  - Influenza-Rhino vaccination within 6 months, but not less than 30 days.
- **In-State (Tennessee) Horses:**
  - Negative EIA (Coggins) test within 12 months
  - Influenza-Rhino vaccination within 6 months, but not less than 30 days.
- **Documentation Submission:**
  - Email all health papers and Coggins to [iroquoismmb@gmail.com](mailto:iroquoismmb@gmail.com).
  - Include trainer's name and number of horses in the subject line.
- **Owner Attendance:**

## Medication & Identification

- **Furosemide (Salix):**
  - Third-party administration in effect.
  - Refer to the 2026 NSA Spring Condition Book for policy details.
  - Contact Dr. Jeff Witwer for questions 803-243-0328.
- **Horse Identification:**
  - Foal papers are not required to be on file with the Horse Identifier at the races providing the horse can be properly identified; and tattoos or microchips are required for all horses, with a one-time exception providing the horse can be identified by his/her markings
  - Scratches must be made at least one hour before post time for the first race.

## Parking, Credentials & Hospitality

- **Parking:**
  - Iroquois Steeplechase stable parking pass or NSA hang-tag required for entry at 2500 Old Hickory Blvd. via Gate 1.
  - All owners, trainers, and riders park in the stable area; shuttles provided to paddock, OTR tent and jockey tent.
- **Hospitality:**
  - Complimentary meals for participating horsemen at the hospitality grill truck located at the stable (Thursday, Friday & Saturday). Check in at race office for wristbands.
  - OTR Hospitality Tent: Lunch, race viewing, and post-race party.
  - Iroquois credentials required for access to the OTR Tent (not NSA pins).
  - Up to four OTR tent tickets per horse. These tickets may be picked up at the race office on race day or may be sent digitally prior to your arrival. - **Travel Information**

Airports: John Tune Airport (615) 350-5000, about 30 minutes from the race grounds, accommodates small aircraft, private and charter.

Nashville International Airport (BNA) is 30 minutes from the steeplechase course, but please allow time for race day traffic. All major airlines serve the Nashville International Airport.

- **Directions**

***Old Hickory Blvd from Hillsboro Rd. to Barn Entrance may be one-way going West mid morning. Please follow the directions listed below, as they are specific for race day. Online GPS instructions may not send you to the horsemen's entrance at Gate 1. Race Day Traffic will be heavy. It is advised to arrive on the grounds by 10am.***

From Nashville International Airport: Take I-40 W toward Memphis. Stay in middle or left lane. Take Exit 213-A (off to left) onto I-440 W "Memphis/Chattanooga". After 3/4 mile, take Exit 53 (off to right) onto I-440 W "Memphis". Off I-440, take Exit 5 to I-65 S. Go to Exit 74-B "Old Hickory Blvd/Brentwood". Exit 74-B goes directly onto Old Hickory Blvd (OHB). Continue along OHB approximately 6.5 miles. Entrance to race grounds is on right at the far side of hill. ON RACE DAY ALLOW PLENTY OF TIME AS TRAFFIC NEAR THE COURSE WILL BE VERY SLOW.

By interstate highway: We are on the SW side of town. From the east, coming into town on I-40, use directions for approach from airport. From the west, or southeast, follow signs to I-65 going south out of town: I-65 S exit 74-B OHB W. Continue down OHB per above directions.

From John C. Tune Airport: Out of gates of airport go to stop sign and turn right onto Centennial Place. Go across RR tracks; turn right at stop sign onto Centennial Blvd. Turn left at traffic light to stay on Centennial Blvd. Then use right lane to take the ramp onto TN-155 S/Briley Pkwy. When you cross I-40, Briley Pkwy will turn into White Bridge Pike; remain on White Bridge Pike for roughly 3 miles. Turn right onto Hwy 70 S/Harding Pike. After 1/2 mile, turn left at onto Belle Meade Blvd. Remain on Belle Meade Blvd for roughly 2 miles, then, after passing golf course, turn left onto Chickering Road. Stay on Chickering until you reach Old Hickory Blvd, then turn right onto Old Hickory Blvd. Finally, stay on Old Hickory Blvd for roughly 1mi, until you reach the racecourse on your right.
