There will be a meeting of Officials at 12:00 p.m. on the first floor of the Stewards' tower.

ATTENTION JOCKEYS: There will be a mandatory meeting of all jockeys with the Stewards at 12:15 p.m. at the Stewards tower. ALL RIDERS MUST ATTEND. All jockeys are reminded to check-in with the Clerk of Scales one hour prior to post time for the first race and report his/her engagement(s) and overweight, if any.

First post for NSA races: 1:30 p.m.

Horses to be ready to leave for the paddock for first race at 1:10 p.m.

There will be a mandatory pre-race vet check at the barn with Dr. Jaime Minnella starting at 9:30 a.m. LASIX HORSES MUST BE ON THE GROUNDS 4 HOURS PRIOR TO POST TIME FOR THEIR SCHEDULED RACE. ALL HORSES MUST BE ON THE GROUNDS 2 HOURS PRIOR TO POST TIME FOR THE FIRST RACE UNLESS EXCUSED BY THE STEWARDS FOR EXTENUATING CIRCUMSTANCES.

THIRD PARTY FUROSEMIDE (SALIX) ADMINISTRATION

Horsemen are reminded that third party administration of furosemide (Salix) is in effect at this race meet. Please refer to the NSA website nationalsteeplechase.com for complete details of the NSA Medication policy. Contact Dr. Jeff Witwer (803-243-0328).

Foal papers are not required to be on file with the Horse Identifier at the races providing the horse can be properly identified; and tattoos or microchip are required for all horses, with a one-time exception providing the horse can be identified by his/her markings. All scratches must be made no later than one hour prior to post time for the first race.

CREDENTIALS NEEDED: NSA pins will allow admittance to most subscriber areas around the race course, including the paddock. NSA hang tags will gain access to the grounds via Gate 2 on Providence Road (stable area only).

Stables and Horse entrance is via Gate 2 off Providence Road closest to Warren Ave.

For Tower, Paddock, and OTR parking use Gate 6.

Note: Warren avenue along the side of the property and to the south of Providence road is a washed out gravel road unsuitable for many vehicles especially horse vans.

Owners, Trainers and Riders with participating horses are invited to the O.T.R. tent by the tower.

Check in next to the O.T.R. tent for credentials for admission to O.T.R. hospitality.

Additional passes for the OTR hospitality can be purchased until Tuesday afternoon at a cost of \$128 per person (max 2 people) from Brooke Pitone (610-388-8383).

Please be advised, due to the PGA Championship golf tournament at Aronimink Golf Club the same weekend as the Races, there may be increased traffic and/or road closures in the Newtown Square area, so plan accordingly.

As we go into the warmer temperatures on racing days, horsemen are reminded that treatment of over-heated horses is based upon science. Those principals are applied by veterinarians attending the horses racing and must be adhered to for the management of heat illness.

Reminder to Horsemen Concerning Heat Illness

The objective is to reduce body heat as quickly as possible and to reduce high brain temperatures. This is accomplished by the application of cold water CONTINUOUSLY to the horse's body and the administration of selected pharmaceuticals intravenously to reduce brain temperatures-most commonly, detomidine. This combination has proven very effective and is based on good research in racing over the past few years. Non-steroidal anti-inflammatory medications may also be used.

The old adage that we should keep the horse moving and forcing them to walk prevents adequate cooling and the efficient administration of the necessary medications by veterinarians. STOP THE HORSE - cool and treat.

No one wants to see a horse go down when struggling with heat and very slow steps forward after treatment may be indicated, but under the supervision of the attending veterinarian. When the horse has made an adequate recovery, then walking or transport may be advised.

Most meets are now set up to provide adequate cooling either with fixed water hoses or portable pressure sprayers followed by cooling fans in the stable area. The portable water tanks with pressure hoses as utilized at many races this spring have been a very useful tool.
