Foal papers will no longer be required to be on file with the Horse Identifier at the races; and tattoos or microchips are required for all horses, with a one-time exception providing the horse can be identified by his/her markings. All scratches must be made no later than one hour prior to post time for the first race.

Attention Horsemen: There will be a mandatory pre-race veterinarian exam with Dr. Kathy Anderson. LASIX HORSES MUST BE ON THE GROUNDS 4 HOURS PRIOR TO POST TIME FOR THEIR SCHEDULED RACE. ALL HORSES MUST BE ON THE GROUNDS 2 HOURS PRIOR TO POST TIME FOR THE FIRST RACE UNLESS EXCUSED BY THE STEWARDS FOR EXTENUATING CIRCUMSTANCES.

Directions: From Philadelphia and the North: I-95 South to Route 322 West. Take 322 West to Route 1 South to the second Kennett Square exit, Rt. 82 North. Follow Rt. 82 North to the stoplight (Rt. 926). Turn right onto Rt. 926 East. The racecourse is located on the left behind the Landhope Farms convenience store.

From Maryland and the South: Take I-95 North from Baltimore to the Perryville exit (Rts. 222 & 275), just past the toll booth. At the light, turn left (away from the outlet mall). Cross over I-95 and continue straight through 2 traffic lights to the dead end. Turn right onto Rt. 276 and bear right onto Rt. 1. Follow Rt. 1 North into Pennsylvania to the Kennett Square, Rt 82 exit. Turn left onto Route 82 North. Follow Rt. 82 North to the stoplight (Rt. 926). Turn right onto Rt. 926 East. The racecourse is located on the left behind the Landhope Farms convenience store.

From Wilmington, DE (Rt. 52 directions): Follow Rt. 52 North and turn left onto Rt. 1 South. Continue on Rt. 1 South to the second Kennett Square exit, Rt. 82 North. Follow Rt. 82 North to the stoplight (Rt. 926). Turn right onto Rt. 926 East. The racecourse is located on the left behind the Landhope Farms convenience store.

From Wilmington, DE (Rt. 202 directions): Take Rt. 202 North and turn left onto Rt. 1 South. Continue on Rt. 1 South to the second Kennett Square exit, Rt. 82 North. Follow Rt. 82 North to the stoplight (Rt. 926). Turn right onto Rt. 926 East. The racecourse is located on the left behind the Landhope Farms convenience store.

From West Chester, PA: Take either Rt. 52 South (or Rt. 202 South) to Rt. 926 West. Follow Rt. 926 West toward Rt. 82. Entrance will be on your right just before the traffic light at Rt. 82.
